Diddle-daddle in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I diddle-daddle	We diddle-daddle
You diddle-daddle	You diddle-daddle
He/She/It diddle-daddles	They diddle-daddle

Diddle-daddle in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am diddle-daddling	We are diddle-daddling
You are diddle-daddling	You are diddle-daddling
He/She/It is diddle-daddling	They are diddle-daddling

Diddle-daddle in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have diddle-daddled	We have diddle-daddled
You have diddle-daddled	You have diddle-daddled
He/She/It has diddle-daddled	They have diddle-daddled

Diddle-daddle in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been diddle-daddling	We have been diddle-daddling
You have been diddle-daddling	You have been diddle-daddling
He/She/It has been diddle-daddling	They have been diddle-daddling

Singular	Plural
I diddle-daddled	We diddle-daddled
You diddle-daddled	You diddle-daddled
He/She/It diddle-daddled	They diddle-daddled

I had been diddle-daddling	We had been diddle-daddling
You had been diddle-daddling	You had been diddle-daddling
He/She/It had been diddle-daddling	They had been diddle-daddling

I will diddle-daddle	We will diddle-daddle
You will diddle-daddle	You will diddle-daddle
He/She/It will diddle-daddle	They will diddle-daddle
