Associations of "Differing" (30 Words)

conflicting	In disagreement- John Morley. <i>There are conflicting accounts of what occurred.</i>
<u>contradiction</u>	The statement of a position opposite to one already made. <i>The proposed new system suffers from a set of internal contradictions.</i>
<u>contradictory</u>	A contradictory proposition. <i>The two studies came to contradictory conclusions.</i>
contrast	The opposition or dissimilarity of things that are compared. <i>People contrasted her with her sister.</i>
contrastingly	In a contrasting manner.
convert	A person who has been converted to another religious or political belief. <i>Could you convert my dollars into pounds.</i>
diametrical	Related to or along a diameter. <i>He s the diametrical opposite of Gabriel.</i>
difference	A disagreement, quarrel, or dispute. <i>There are many differences between jazz and rock.</i>
different	Distinctly separate from the first. <i>Each interviewed different members of the community.</i>
<u>differential</u>	A set of gears allowing a motor vehicle’s driven wheels to revolve at different speeds when going around corners. <i>The differential between petrol and diesel prices.</i>
<u>differentiation</u>	(biology) the structural adaptation of some body part for a particular function. <i>Cell differentiation in the developing embryo.</i>
<u>disagree</u>	(of food, climate, or an experience) have an adverse effect on. <i>She disagrees with her husband on many questions.</i>
<u>disagreement</u>	The speech act of disagreeing or arguing or disputing. <i>Disagreements between parents and adolescents.</i>

<u>discord</u>	Lack of harmony between notes sounding together. <i>The music faded in discord.</i>
<u>discordant</u>	(of sounds) harsh and jarring because of a lack of harmony. <i>A study of children in discordant homes.</i>
discrepant	Not in accord. <i>The reasons for these discrepant results are unclear.</i>
dissonant	Unsuitable or unusual in combination; clashing. <i>Irregular dissonant chords.</i>
<u>distinction</u>	A grade in an examination denoting excellence. <i>It is necessary to make a distinction between love and infatuation.</i>
<u>erratic</u>	Not even or regular in pattern or movement; unpredictable. <i>Erratic behavior.</i>
factious	Relating or inclined to dissension. <i>A factious country.</i>
gap	Make an opening or gap in. <i>There are many gaps in our understanding of what happened.</i>
<u>incompatible</u>	Not suitable to your tastes or needs. <i>Long hours are simply incompatible with family life.</i>
<u>incongruous</u>	Not in harmony or keeping with the surroundings or other aspects of something. <i>The duffel coat looked incongruous with the black dress she wore underneath.</i>
inconsistent	Acting at variance with one's own principles or former behaviour. <i>Inconsistent statements cannot both be true at the same time.</i>
inharmonious	Not in harmony. <i>An inharmonious negative state of mind.</i>
inhospitable	Not hospitable. <i>The barren inhospitable desert.</i>
<u>irony</u>	Witty language used to convey insults or scorn-Jonathan Swif. <i>Don't go overboard with the gratitude he rejoined with heavy irony.</i>
<u>opposition</u>	An armed adversary (especially a member of an opposing military force). <i>The invaders encountered stiff opposition.</i>
<u>unlike</u>	Dissimilar or different from each other. <i>They seemed utterly unlike despite being twins.</i>
<u>variance</u>	The quality of being subject to variation. <i>They were at variance with all their previous allies.</i>
