Past Tense	<b>difficultated</b>
Present Participle	<b>difficultating</b>
Past Participle	<b>difficultated</b>

**Plural**

I **difficultate**                      We **difficultate**  
You **difficultate**                    You **difficultate**  
He/She/It **difficultates**      They **difficultate**

**Difficultate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am difficultating**                We **are difficultating**  
You **are difficultating**            You **are difficultating**  
He/She/It **is difficultating**      They **are difficultating**

**Difficultate in Present Perfect Tense**

I **have difficultated**                We **have difficultated**  
You **have difficultated**            You **have difficultated**  
He/She/It **has difficultated**      They **have difficultated**
