- *Capable of being converted into assimilable condition in the alimentary canal.*



Synonyms of "Digestible" as an adjective (17 Words)

articulate

Expressing yourself easily or characterized by clear expressive language.

***Articulate** speech.*

clear

Clear and distinct to the senses easily perceptible.

*The letter brought back a **clear** image of his grandfather.*

coherent

Marked by an orderly, logical, and aesthetically consistent relation of parts.

*She was more **coherent** than she had been just after the accident.*

comestible

Edible.

*Sugar coffee and sundry other **comestible** requisites.*

comprehensible

Capable of being comprehended or understood.

*An idea **comprehensible** to the average mind.*

consumable

(of an item for sale) intended to be used up and then replaced.

*You will have to pay for **consumable** materials such as butane gas canisters.*

crystalline

Distinctly or sharply outlined.

*The cold **crystalline** water of melted snow.*

fit for human consumption

On the point of or strongly disposed.

fit to be eaten

Physically and mentally sound or healthy.

fit to eat

Physically and mentally sound or healthy.

good to eat

Thorough.

intelligible

Able to be understood; comprehensible.

***Intelligible** pronunciation.*

lucid

Bright or luminous.

*A **lucid** moment in his madness.*

palatable

Acceptable to the taste or mind.

***Palatable** food.*

safe to eat

Free from danger or the risk of harm.

understandable

To be expected; natural, reasonable, or forgivable.

*It is **understandable** that mistakes occur sometimes.*

wholesome

Conducive to or characteristic of physical or moral well-being.

*Exercise develops **wholesome** appetites.*
