Diagnosce in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular**Plural**

I was diagnosing	We were diagnosing
You were diagnosing	You were diagnosing
He/She/It was diagnosing	They were diagnosing

Dignosce in Past Perfect Tense**Singular****Plural**

I had dignosced	We had dignosced
You had dignosced	You had dignosced
He/She/It had dignosced	They had dignosced

Dignosce in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**Singular****Plural**

I had been diagnosing	We had been diagnosing
You had been diagnosing	You had been diagnosing
He/She/It had been diagnosing	They had been diagnosing

Dignosce in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**Singular****Plural**

I will dignosce	We will dignosce
You will dignosce	You will dignosce
He/She/It will dignosce	They will dignosce

Dignosce in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**Singular****Plural**

I will be diagnosing	We will be diagnosing
You will be diagnosing	You will be diagnosing
He/She/It will be diagnosing	They will be diagnosing
