Conjugate Dijudicate

Dijudicate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **dijudicate** We **dijudicate**
You **dijudicate** You **dijudicate**
He/She/It **dijudicates** They **dijudicate**

Dijudicate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am dijudicating** We **are dijudicating**
You **are dijudicating** You **are dijudicating**
He/She/It **is dijudicating** They **are dijudicating**

Dijudicate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have dijudicated** We **have dijudicated**
You **have dijudicated** You **have dijudicated**
He/She/It **has dijudicated** They **have dijudicated**

Dijudicate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I **have been dijudicating** We **have been dijudicating**
You **have been dijudicating** You **have been dijudicating**
He/She/It **has been dijudicating** They **have been dijudicating**

Dijudicate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was **dijudicating** We were **dijudicating**
You were **dijudicating** You were **dijudicating**
He/She/It was **dijudicating** They were **dijudicating**

I had **dijudicated** We had **dijudicated**
You had **dijudicated** You had **dijudicated**
He/She/It had **dijudicated** They had **dijudicated**
