# **Conjugate Dimidiate**

## **Dimidiate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>dimidiate</b>	We <b>dimidiate</b>
You <b>dimidiate</b>	You <b>dimidiate</b>
He/She/It <b>dimidiates</b>	They <b>dimidiate</b>

## **Dimidiate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am dimidiating	We <b>are dimidiating</b>
You <b>are dimidiating</b>	You are dimidiating
He/She/It is dimidiating	They are dimidiating

#### **Dimidiate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have dimidiated	We have dimidiated
You <b>have dimidiated</b>	You have dimidiated
He/She/It has dimidiated	They have dimidiated

## **Dimidiate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been dimidiating	We <b>have been dimidiating</b>
You <b>have been dimidiating</b>	You <b>have been dimidiating</b>
He/She/It has been dimidiating	They have been dimidiating

## **Dimidiate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I dimidiated	We <b>dimidiated</b>
You <b>dimidiated</b>	You <b>dimidiated</b>
He/She/It <b>dimidiated</b>	They <b>dimidiated</b>

#### **Dimidiate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was dimidiating	We were dimidiating
You <b>were dimidiating</b>	You were dimidiating
He/She/It was dimidiating	They were dimidiating

#### **Dimidiate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had dimidiated	We had dimidiated
You had dimidiated	You had dimidiated
He/She/It had dimidiated	They had dimidiated

### **Dimidiate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been dimidiating	We had been dimidiating
You <b>had been dimidiating</b>	You had been dimidiating
He/She/It had been dimidiating	They had been dimidiating

## **Dimidiate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will dimidiate	We will dimidiate
You <b>will dimidiate</b>	You <b>will dimidiate</b>
He/She/It will dimidiate	They will dimidiate

## **Dimidiate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be dimidiating	We will be dimidiating
You <b>will be dimidiating</b>	You <b>will be dimidiating</b>
He/She/It will be dimidiating	They will be dimidiating

Singular	Plural
I will have been dimidiating	We <b>will have been dimidiating</b>
You <b>will have been dimidiating</b>	You will have been dimidiating
He/She/It will have been dimidiating	They will have been dimidiating
