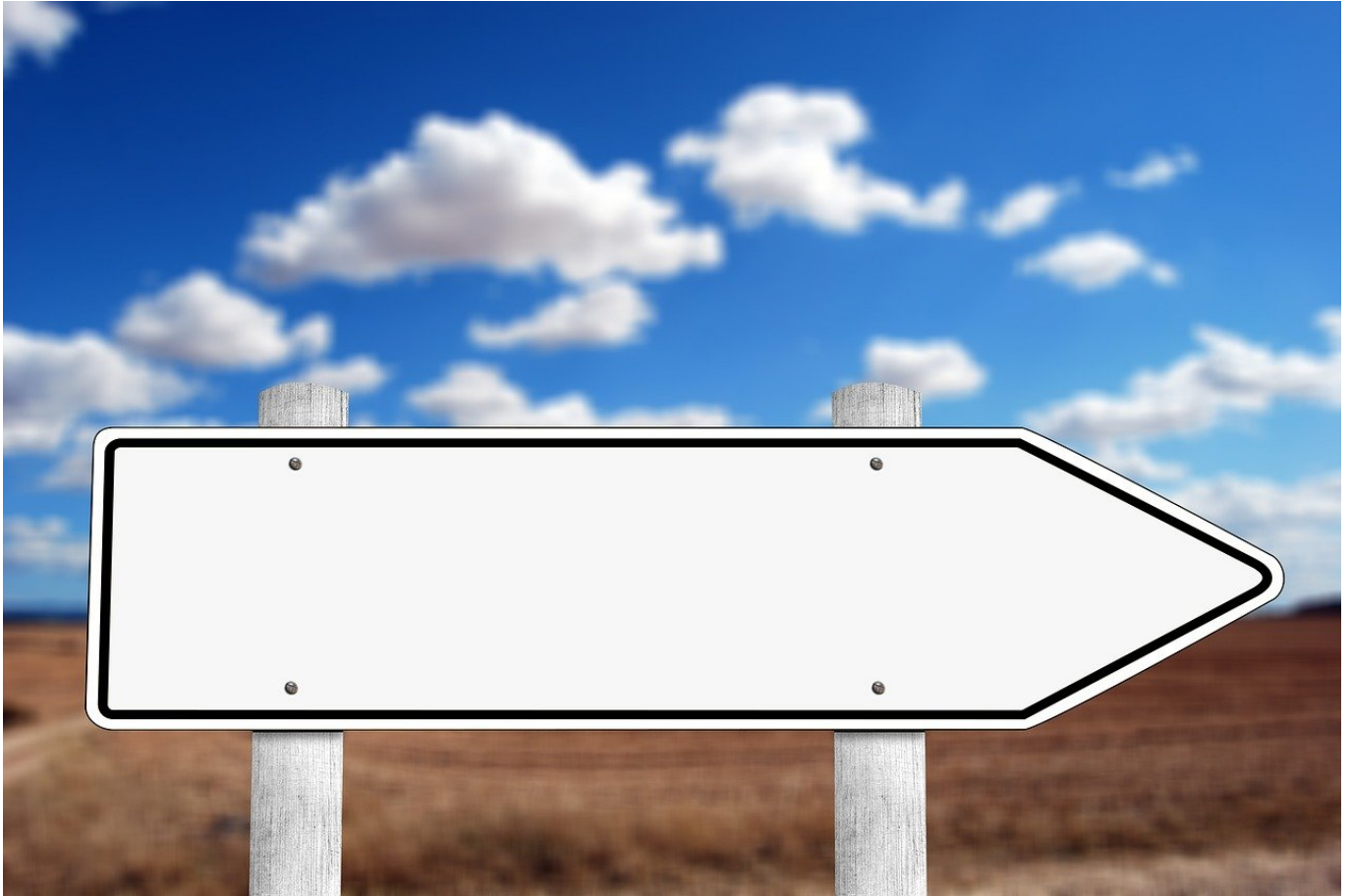

## Directory as a Noun

### Definitions of "Directory" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “directory” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A book or website listing individuals or organizations alphabetically or thematically with details such as names, addresses, and phone numbers.*
- *A board in an organization or large store listing names and locations of departments, individuals, etc.*
- *An alphabetical list of names and addresses.*
- *The revolutionary government in France 1795–9, comprising two councils and a five-member executive. It maintained an aggressive foreign policy, but could not control events at home and was overthrown by Napoleon Bonaparte.*
- *A book of directions for the conduct of Christian worship, especially in Presbyterian and Roman Catholic Churches.*
- *A file which consists solely of a set of other files (which may themselves be directories).*
- *(computer science) a listing of the files stored in memory (usually on a hard disk.*
- *A listing of the files stored in memory (usually on a hard disk.*

- archive** A depository containing historical records and documents.  
*A section of **archive** film.*
- catalogue** A publication containing details of items for sale, especially one produced by a mail-order company.  
*A computerized library **catalogue**.*
- index** A pointer on an instrument, showing a quantity, a position on a scale, etc.  
*The hundred shares **index** closed down 9 3.*
- inventory** (accounting) the value of a firm's current assets including raw materials and work in progress and finished goods.

- list** A formal structure analogous to a list by which items of data can be stored or processed in a definite order.  
*The ship developed a **list** to starboard.*
- listing** The drawing up of a list.

**record** Anything such as a document or a phonograph record or a photograph providing permanent evidence of or information about past events.  
**Record profits.**

**register** A cashbox with an adding machine to register transactions used in shops to add up the bill.  
A membership **register**.



## Associations of "Directory" (30 Words)

<b><u>annotate</u></b>	Provide interlinear explanations for words or phrases. <i>The scholar <b>annotated</b> the early edition of a famous novel.</i>
<b><u>bookmark</u></b>	A marker (a piece of paper or ribbon) placed between the pages of a book to mark the reader's place. <i>Fans will want to <b>bookmark</b> this site.</i>
<b>brochure</b>	A small book or magazine containing pictures and information about a product or service. <i>A holiday <b>brochure</b>.</i>
<b><u>checklist</u></b>	A list of items required, things to be done, or points to be considered, used as a reminder.
<b><u>compile</u></b>	Accumulate (a specified score). <i>The local authority must <b>compile</b> a list of the names and addresses of taxpayers.</i>
<b><u>data</u></b>	Things known or assumed as facts, making the basis of reasoning or calculation. <i>There is very little <b>data</b> available.</i>
<b>datum</b>	A fixed starting point of a scale or operation. <i>An accurate <b>datum</b> is formed by which other machining operations can be carried out.</i>
<b><u>descriptive</u></b>	Serving to describe or inform or characterized by description. <i>The text contains some good <b>descriptive</b> passages.</i>
<b>desktop</b>	The working area of a computer screen regarded as a representation of a notional desktop and containing icons representing items such as files. <i>You can now have multiple overlapping windows on the <b>desktop</b>.</i>
<b>disk</b>	Sound recording consisting of a disk with a continuous groove used to reproduce music by rotating while a phonograph needle tracks in the groove. <i>The moon s <b>disk</b> hung in a cloudless sky.</i>
<b><u>dossier</u></b>	A collection of papers containing detailed information about a particular person or subject (usually a person's record). <i>We have a <b>dossier</b> on him.</i>
<b>edition</b>	A particular version of a text maintained by regular revision. <i>He read it in yesterday s <b>edition</b> of the Times.</i>
<b><u>file</u></b>	File a formal charge against. <i><b>File</b> for divorce.</i>
<b>folder</b>	A folded leaflet or a booklet made of folded sheets of paper.

<b>guide</b>	Use as a guide. <i>They had the lights to <b>guide</b> on.</i>
<b>handbook</b>	A concise reference book providing specific information about a subject or location. <i>A <b>handbook</b> of poisonous plants.</i>
<a href="#"><u>index</u></a>	Link the value of prices wages or other payments automatically to the value of a price index. <i>The Supreme Soviet passed legislation <b>indexing</b> wages to prices.</i>
<b>information</b>	In information theory a mathematical quantity expressing the probability of occurrence of a particular sequence of symbols impulses etc as against that of alternative sequences. <i>Genetically transmitted <b>information</b>.</i>
<b>instructions</b>	A manual usually accompanying a technical device and explaining how to install or operate it.
<b>item</b>	Also Philip Guedalla used when listing or enumerating items. <i>An <b>item</b> of clothing.</i>
<b>leaflet</b>	Distribute leaflets to people or an area. <i>Tourists visiting the area are being <b>leafleted</b>.</i>
<b>listing</b>	A database containing an ordered array of items (names or topics).
<b>pamphlet</b>	Distribute pamphlets to. <i>He published a spate of <b>pamphlets</b> on the subjects about which he felt strongly.</i>
<b>peruse</b>	Examine carefully or at length. <i>Laura <b>perused</b> a Caravaggio.</i>
<b>prospectus</b>	A formal written offer to sell securities (filed with the SEC) that sets forth a plan for a (proposed) business enterprise. <i>A <b>prospectus</b> should contain the facts that an investor needs to make an informed decision.</i>
<a href="#"><u>register</u></a>	A cashbox with an adding machine to register transactions used in shops to add up the bill. <i>At the store s bridal registry single people can <b>register</b> for gifts even if they are not getting married.</i>
<b>sampling</b>	Measurement at regular intervals of the amplitude of a varying waveform (in order to convert it to digital form). <i>Routine river <b>sampling</b> is carried out according to a schedule.</i>
<b>studying</b>	Reading carefully with intent to remember.
<a href="#"><u>text</u></a>	A textbook. <i>Too much concentration on set <b>texts</b> can turn pupils against reading.</i>
