Present Tense	<b>disadvise / disadvises</b>
Past Tense	<b>disadvised</b>
Present Participle	<b>disadvising</b>
Past Participle	<b>disadvised</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **disadvise**                      We **disadvise**  
You **disadvise**                You **disadvise**  
He/She/It **disadvise**s      They **disadvise**

**Disadvise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am advising**                We **are advising**  
You **are advising**            You **are advising**  
He/She/It **is advising**      They **are advising**

**Disadvise in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have advised**                We **have advised**  
You **have advised**            You **have advised**  
He/She/It **has advised**      They **have advised**

**Disadvise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been advising**        We **have been advising**  
You **have been advising**      You **have been advising**  
He/She/It **has been advising**      They **have been advising**

**Disadvise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **advised**                      We **advised**  
You **advised**                You **advised**  
He/She/It **advised**        They **advised**

**Disadvise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **was disadvising**      We **were disadvising**  
You **were disadvising**      You **were disadvising**  
He/She/It **was disadvising**      They **were disadvising**

**Disadvise in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

I **had disadvised**      We **had disadvised**  
You **had disadvised**      You **had disadvised**  
He/She/It **had disadvised**      They **had disadvised**

**Disadvise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **had been disadvising**      We **had been disadvising**  
You **had been disadvising**      You **had been disadvising**  
He/She/It **had been disadvising**      They **had been disadvising**

**Disadvise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will advise**      We **will advise**  
You **will advise**      You **will advise**  
He/She/It **will advise**      They **will advise**

**Disadvise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be disadvising**      We **will be disadvising**  
You **will be disadvising**      You **will be disadvising**  
He/She/It **will be disadvising**      They **will be disadvising**

**Disadvise in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have disadvised**

**We will have disadvised**

**You will have disadvised**

**You will have disadvised**

**He/She/It will have disadvised** **They will have disadvised**

**Disadvise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been disadvising**

**We will have been disadvising**

**You will have been disadvising**

**You will have been disadvising**

**He/She/It will have been disadvising** **They will have been disadvising**
