## Synonyms of "Disappearance" as a noun (20 Words)

<b>coming to an end</b>	The moment of most intense pleasure in sexual intercourse.
<b>death</b>	The personification of death. <i>He seemed more content in <b>death</b> than he had ever been in life.</i>
<b>disappearing</b>	The act of leaving secretly or without explanation.
<b>dying</b>	The time when something ends. <i>A <b>dying</b> of old hopes.</i>
<b>dying out</b>	The time when something ends.
<b>ending</b>	The act of ending something. <i>The student has to choose the right plural <b>endings</b>.</i>
<b>expiry</b>	A coming to an end of a contract period. <i>The <b>expiry</b> of the patent.</i>

<b>extinction</b>	The fact or process of a species, family, or other group of animals or plants becoming extinct. <i>A private debt <b>extinction</b> fund.</i>
<b>fade</b>	A golf shot that curves to the right for a right-handed golfer. <i>The sun can cause colour <b>fade</b>.</i>
<b>fading</b>	Weakening in force or intensity.
<b>fading away</b>	Weakening in force or intensity.
<b>fizzling out</b>	A failure by a batter or runner to reach a base safely in baseball.
<b>loss</b>	Something that is lost. <i><b>Loss</b> of livestock left the rancher bankrupt.</i>
<b>melting away</b>	The process whereby heat changes something from a solid to a liquid.
<b>passing away</b>	A play that involves one player throwing the ball to a teammate.
<b>passing from sight</b>	A bodily reaction of changing from one place or stage to another.
<b>passing into oblivion</b>	Success in satisfying a test or requirement.
<b>petering out</b>	A failure by a batter or runner to reach a base safely in baseball.
<b>vanishing</b>	A sudden disappearance from sight.
<b>withering away</b>	Any weakening or degeneration (especially through lack of use).

**cryptic**

Having a secret or hidden meaning.  
*He found his boss's utterances too cryptic.*

**disappear**

Get lost, as without warning or explanation.  
*It is estimated that some 7000 people have been disappeared by security forces.*

**disintegration**

The spontaneous disintegration of a radioactive substance along with the emission of ionizing radiation.  
*A disintegration of personality.*

**dissipate**

Live a life of pleasure, especially with respect to alcoholic consumption.  
*He wanted to dissipate his anger.*

**dissipation**

Breaking up and scattering by dispersion.  
*The dissipation of the mist.*

<b>dissolution</b>	The termination of a meeting. <i>Minerals susceptible to <b>dissolution</b>.</i>
<b>enigmatic</b>	Resembling an oracle in obscurity of thought. <i>Prophetic texts so <b>enigmatic</b> that their meaning has been disputed for centuries.</i>
<b>evaporation</b>	The process of something abstract ceasing to exist. <i>Thousands of employees witnessed the rapid <b>evaporation</b> of their retirement plans.</i>
<b>extravagance</b>	A thing on which too much money has been spent or which has used up too many resources. <i>Salmon trout is an unnecessary <b>extravagance</b>.</i>
<b>fade</b>	A haircut in which the hair is left long on top of the head but cropped close to the sides and back with the length of hair gradually decreasing. <i>He skilfully <b>fades</b> the guitar lines up and down.</i>
<b>incomprehensible</b>	Not able to be understood; not intelligible. <i>The most <b>incomprehensible</b> thing about the universe is that it is comprehensible.</i>
<b>inexplicable</b>	Incapable of being explained or accounted for. <i><b>Inexplicable</b> errors.</i>
<b>inscrutable</b>	Impossible to understand or interpret. <i>Guy looked blankly <b>inscrutable</b>.</i>
<b>looseness</b>	The quality of movability by virtue of being free from attachment or other restraints. <i>The flexibility and <b>looseness</b> of the materials from which mythology is made.</i>
<b>miss</b>	Fail to see or have a meeting with (someone). <i>The arrow <b>missed</b> the target.</i>
<b>mysterious</b>	Of an obscure nature. <i>A dark <b>mysterious</b> windowless building.</i>
<b>obscurity</b>	The state of being indistinct or indefinite for lack of adequate illumination. <i>He is too good a player to slide into <b>obscurity</b>.</i>
<b>occult</b>	Supernatural forces and events and beings collectively. <i>The beam of light <b>occults</b> every so often.</i>
<b>odd</b>	Separated from a usual pair or set and therefore out of place or mismatched. <i>Invited 30 <b>odd</b> guests.</i>

<b><u>puzzling</u></b>	Not clear to the understanding. <i>Only one very <b>puzzling</b> question remains unanswered.</i>
<b><u>scatter</u></b>	The scattering of light other electromagnetic radiation or particles. <b>Scatter</b> cards across the table.
<b>sibylline</b>	Resembling or characteristic of a prophet or prophecy. <i>His fascinating if sometimes <b>sibylline</b> meditations on the nation.</i>
<b>sudden</b>	Suddenly. A <b>sudden</b> storm.
<b>unaccountable</b>	Not to be accounted for or explained. <i>A powerful and <b>unaccountable</b> institution.</i>
<b>uncanny</b>	Surpassing the ordinary or normal - George Will. <i>Stumps had <b>uncanny</b> shapes as of monstrous creatures.</i>
<b><u>vanish</u></b>	Get lost, as without warning or explanation. <i>The money <b>vanished</b> in las Vegas.</i>
<b>vaporize</b>	Convert or be converted into vapour. <i>Cold gasoline does not <b>vaporize</b> readily.</i>
<b><u>wasteful</u></b>	Inefficient in use of time and effort and materials. <i>A clumsy and <b>wasteful</b> process.</i>
<b><u>weird</u></b>	Suggesting something supernatural; unearthly. <b>Weird</b> inhuman sounds.
