The Forms of Disappoint

Infinitive to disappoint

Present Tense disappoint / disappoints

Past Tense **disappointed**Present Participle **disappointing**Past Participle **disappointed**

Conjugate Disappoint

Disappoint in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I disappoint We disappoint
You disappoint You disappoint
He/She/It disappoints They disappoint

Disappoint in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am disappointing We are disappointing
You are disappointing You are disappointing
He/She/It is disappointing They are disappointing

Disappoint in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have disappointed We have disappointed You have disappointed He/She/It has disappointed They have disappointed

Disappoint in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been disappointing

You have been disappointing

You have been disappointing

He/She/It has been disappointing

They have been disappointing

Disappoint in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I disappointed We disappointed
You disappointed You disappointed
He/She/It disappointed They disappointed

Disappoint in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was disappointing We were disappointing
You were disappointing
He/She/It was disappointing They were disappointing

Disappoint in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had disappointed We had disappointed
You had disappointed You had disappointed
He/She/It had disappointed They had disappointed

Disappoint in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been disappointing We had been disappointing
You had been disappointing You had been disappointing
He/She/It had been disappointing They had been disappointing

Disappoint in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will disappoint We will disappoint
You will disappoint You will disappoint
He/She/It will disappoint They will disappoint

Disappoint in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be disappointing
You will be disappointing
He/She/It will be disappointing
They will be disappointing

Disappoint in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have disappointed We will have disappointed You will have disappointed He/She/It will have disappointed They will have disappointed

Disappoint in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been disappointing
You will have been disappointing
He/She/It will have been disappointing
They will have been disappointing
