# **Conjugate Disbelieve**

## **Disbelieve in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I disbelieve	We <b>disbelieve</b>
You <b>disbelieve</b>	You <b>disbelieve</b>
He/She/It <b>disbelieves</b>	They <b>disbelieve</b>

## **Disbelieve in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am disbelieving	We are disbelieving
You <b>are disbelieving</b>	You are disbelieving
He/She/It is disbelieving	They are disbelieving

#### **Disbelieve in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have disbelieved	We have disbelieved
You have disbelieved	You have disbelieved
He/She/It has disbelieved	They have disbelieved

## **Disbelieve in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been disbelieving	We <b>have been disbelieving</b>
You <b>have been disbelieving</b>	You <b>have been disbelieving</b>
He/She/It has been disbelieving	They have been disbelieving

## **Disbelieve in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I disbelieved	We <b>disbelieved</b>
You <b>disbelieved</b>	You <b>disbelieved</b>
He/She/It <b>disbelieved</b>	They <b>disbelieved</b>

#### **Disbelieve in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was disbelieving	We were disbelieving
You <b>were disbelieving</b>	You were disbelieving
He/She/It was disbelieving	They were disbelieving

#### **Disbelieve in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had disbelieved	We had disbelieved
You had disbelieved	You had disbelieved
He/She/It had disbelieved	They had disbelieved

#### **Disbelieve in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been disbelieving	We had been disbelieving
You <b>had been disbelieving</b>	You <b>had been disbelieving</b>
He/She/It had been disbelieving	They had been disbelieving

## **Disbelieve in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will disbelieve	We will disbelieve
You <b>will disbelieve</b>	You <b>will disbelieve</b>
He/She/It will disbelieve	They will disbelieve

## **Disbelieve in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be disbelieving	We will be disbelieving
You <b>will be disbelieving</b>	You will be disbelieving
He/She/It will be disbelieving	They will be disbelieving

### **Disbelieve in Future Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been disbelieving	We <b>will have been disbelieving</b>
You <b>will have been disbelieving</b>	You <b>will have been disbelieving</b>
He/She/It will have been disbelieving	They will have been disbelieving
