### Definitions of "Disc" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “disc” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Sound recording consisting of a disk with a continuous groove; used to reproduce music by rotating while a phonograph needle tracks in the groove.*
- *Something with a round shape resembling a flat circular plate.*
- *An object or part resembling a disc in shape or appearance.*
- *A memory device consisting of a flat disk covered with a magnetic coating on which information is stored.*
- *The central part of the flower of a daisy or other composite plant, consisting of a close-packed cluster of tubular florets.*
- *(computer science) a memory device consisting of a flat disk covered with a magnetic coating on which information is stored.*
- *A layer of cartilage separating adjacent vertebrae in the spine.*
- *A CD or record.*
- *A flat circular plate.*
- *A flat, thin circular object.*
- *One of the suits in some tarot packs, corresponding to coins in others.*

- An information storage device for a computer in the shape of a round flat plate which can be rotated to give access to all parts of the surface. The data may be stored either magnetically (in a magnetic disk) or optically (in an optical disk such as a CD-ROM).

<b>album</b>	One or more recordings issued together; originally released on 12-inch phonograph records (usually with attractive record covers) and later on cassette audiotape and compact disc. <i>The wedding pictures had pride of place in the family <b>album</b>.</i>
<b>band</b>	A range of frequencies or wavelengths in a spectrum. <i>A long narrow <b>band</b> of cloud.</i>
<b><u>circle</u></b>	Something approximating the shape of a circle. <i>They had excellent seats in the dress <b>circle</b>.</i>
<b>circlet</b>	A circular band, typically one made of precious metal, worn on the head as an ornament.

<b>discus</b>	An athletic competition in which a disk-shaped object is thrown as far as possible.
<b>disk</b>	A memory device consisting of a flat disk covered with a magnetic coating on which information is stored. <i>The moon s <b>disk</b> hung in a cloudless sky.</i>
<b>gramophone record</b>	An antique record player; the sound of the vibrating needle is amplified acoustically.
<b>hoop</b>	Horizontal circular metal hoop supporting a net through which players try to throw the basketball. <i>A woman in <b>hoops</b> and crinoline.</i>
<b>lp</b>	A long-playing phonograph record; designed to be played at 33.3 rpm.
<b>phonograph record</b>	Machine in which rotating records cause a stylus to vibrate and the vibrations are amplified acoustically or electronically.
<b>phonograph recording</b>	Machine in which rotating records cause a stylus to vibrate and the vibrations are amplified acoustically or electronically.
<b>platter</b>	A quantity of food served on a platter. <i>His son s fascination with a Jimi Hendrix collection prompted him to dig out some old <b>platters</b>.</i>
<b>record</b>	A piece or collection of music reproduced on a record or on another medium. <i>The lawyer has a good <b>record</b>.</i>
<b>ring</b>	The sound of a bell ringing E A Poe. <i>Through traffic is diverted along the outer <b>ring</b>.</i>
<b><u>round</u></b>	(sports) a division during which one team is on the offensive. <i>There was a <b>round</b> of applause.</i>
<b>saucer</b>	A small shallow dish for holding a cup at the table.
<b>vinyl</b>	A vinyl record. <i><b>Vinyl</b> floor tiles.</i>

<b>discus</b>	A small colourful South American freshwater fish with a rounded laterally compressed body, native to South America and popular in aquariums.
<b>disk</b>	A memory device consisting of a flat disk covered with a magnetic coating on which information is stored. <i>The moon s <b>disk</b> hung in a cloudless sky.</i>
<b>even</b>	Make or become even. <i>He enjoyed the <b>evening</b> light across the lake.</i>
<b>flat</b>	Of a key having a flat or flats in the signature. <i><b>Flat</b> computer monitors.</i>
<b>frame</b>	The hard structure bones and cartilages that provides a frame for the body of an animal. <i>An utterance may mean the opposite of what it says if used within a <b>frame</b> of teasing.</i>
<b>fretwork</b>	Ornamental design in wood, typically openwork, done with a fretsaw.
<b>hexagonal</b>	Relating to or constituting a hexagon; having six straight sides and six angles. <i>Small <b>hexagonal</b> pockets of honeycomb.</i>
<b>lattice</b>	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. <i>Honeysuckle was growing up a <b>lattice</b> round the door.</i>
<b>latticed</b>	Decorated with or in the form of a lattice. <i>A <b>latticed</b> screen.</i>
<b>oblate</b>	A lay person dedicated to religious work or the religious life.
<b>octagon</b>	An object or building with an octagonal plan or cross section.
<b>pane</b>	A panel or section of panels in a wall or door.
<b>pentagram</b>	A five-pointed star that is formed by drawing a continuous line in five straight segments, often used as a mystic and magical symbol.
<b>pentavalent</b>	Having a valence of five.
<b>pulp</b>	Remove the pulp from as from a fruit. <i><b>Pulp</b> fruit.</i>
<b>quadrate</b>	(in the skull of a bird or reptile) a squarish bone with which the jaw articulates, thought to be homologous with the incus of the middle ear in mammals. <i>He had to make a creed which would <b>quadrate</b> with his immorality.</i>
<b>record</b>	Sound recording consisting of a disk with a continuous groove used to reproduce music by rotating while a phonograph needle tracks in the groove. <i>The coroner <b>recorded</b> a verdict of accidental death.</i>
<b>saucer</b>	Something with a round shape resembling a flat circular plate.

- shaped** Shaped to fit by or as if by altering the contours of a pliable mass as by work or effort.  
*An enclosed back garden with a **shaped** lawn.*
