- An object or part resembling a disc in shape or appearance.
- A memory device consisting of a flat disk covered with a magnetic coating on which information is stored.
- The central part of the flower of a daisy or other composite plant, consisting of a close-packed cluster of tubular florets.
- (computer science) a memory device consisting of a flat disk covered with a magnetic coating on which information is stored.
- A layer of cartilage separating adjacent vertebrae in the spine.
- A CD or record.
- A flat circular plate.
- A flat, thin circular object.
- One of the suits in some tarot packs, corresponding to coins in others.



• An information storage device for a computer in the shape of a round flat plate which can be rotated to give access to all parts of the surface. The data may be stored either magnetically (in a magnetic disk) or optically (in an optical disk such as a CD-ROM).
