Past Tense	<b>discompanied</b>
Present Participle	<b>discompanying</b>
Past Participle	<b>discompanied</b>

**Discompany in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **discompany**                      We **discompany**  
You **discompany**                      You **discompany**  
He/She/It **discompanies**      They **discompany**

**Discompany in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am discompanying**                      We **are discompanying**  
You **are discompanying**                      You **are discompanying**  
He/She/It **is discompanying**      They **are discompanying**

**Discompany in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have discompanied**                      We **have discompanied**  
You **have discompanied**                      You **have discompanied**  
He/She/It **has discompanied**      They **have discompanied**

**Discompany in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been discompanying**                      We **have been discompanying**  
You **have been discompanying**                      You **have been discompanying**  
He/She/It **has been discompanying**      They **have been discompanying**

**Discompany in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **discompanied**                      We **discompanied**  
You **discompanied**                      You **discompanied**  
He/She/It **discompanied**      They **discompanied**

**Discompany in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I was **discompanied**                      We were **discompanied**  
You were **discompanied**              You were **discompanied**  
He/She/It was **discompanied**      They were **discompanied**

**Discompanied in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

I had **discompanied**                      We had **discompanied**  
You had **discompanied**              You had **discompanied**  
He/She/It had **discompanied**      They had **discompanied**

**Discompanied in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I had been **discompanied**              We had been **discompanied**  
You had been **discompanied**          You had been **discompanied**  
He/She/It had been **discompanied**      They had been **discompanied**

**Discompanied in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will **discompany**                      We will **discompany**  
You will **discompany**              You will **discompany**  
He/She/It will **discompany**      They will **discompany**

**Discompanied in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be **discompanied**              We will be **discompanied**  
You will be **discompanied**          You will be **discompanied**  
He/She/It will be **discompanied**      They will be **discompanied**

**Discompanied in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have discompanied**

**We will have discompanied**

**You will have discompanied**

**You will have discompanied**

**He/She/It will have discompanied**

**They will have discompanied**

**Discompany in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**I will have been discompanying**

**We will have been discompanying**

**You will have been discompanying**

**You will have been discompanying**

**He/She/It will have been discompanying**

**They will have been discompanying**
