I **discomplexion** We **discomplexion**
You **discomplexion** You **discomplexion**
He/She/It **discomplexions** They **discomplexion**

Discomplexion in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am discomplexioning** We **are discomplexioning**
You **are discomplexioning** You **are discomplexioning**
He/She/It **is discomplexioning** They **are discomplexioning**

Discomplexion in Present Perfect Tense

I **have discomplexioned** We **have discomplexioned**
You **have discomplexioned** You **have discomplexioned**

I will have discomplexioned

We will have discomplexioned

You will have discomplexioned

You will have discomplexioned
