Disconsecrate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **disconsecrate** We **disconsecrate**
You **disconsecrate** You **disconsecrate**
He/She/It **disconsecrates** They **disconsecrate**

Disconsecrate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am disconsecrating** We **are disconsecrating**
You **are disconsecrating** You **are disconsecrating**
He/She/It **is disconsecrating** They **are disconsecrating**

Disconsecrate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have disconsecrated** We **have disconsecrated**
You **have disconsecrated** You **have disconsecrated**
He/She/It **has disconsecrated** They **have disconsecrated**

Disconsecrate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I **have been disconsecrating** We **have been disconsecrating**
You **have been disconsecrating** You **have been disconsecrating**
He/She/It **has been disconsecrating** They **have been disconsecrating**

I **disconsecrated** We **disconsecrated**
You **disconsecrated** You **disconsecrated**
He/She/It **disconsecrated** They **disconsecrated**

Disconsecrate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was **disconsecrating** We were **disconsecrating**
You were **disconsecrating** You were **disconsecrating**
He/She/It was **disconsecrating** They were **disconsecrating**

Disconsecrate in Past Perfect Tense

I had **disconsecrated** We had **disconsecrated**
You had **disconsecrated** You had **disconsecrated**
He/She/It had **disconsecrated** They had **disconsecrated**

I had been **disconsecrating** We had been **disconsecrating**
You had been **disconsecrating** You had been **disconsecrating**
He/She/It had been **disconsecrating** They had been **disconsecrating**

I will **disconsecrate** We will **disconsecrate**
You will **disconsecrate** You will **disconsecrate**
He/She/It will **disconsecrate** They will **disconsecrate**

I will be **disconsecrating** We will be **disconsecrating**
You will be **disconsecrating** You will be **disconsecrating**
He/She/It will be **disconsecrating** They will be **disconsecrating**

Disconsecrate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have disconsecrated

We will have disconsecrated

You will have disconsecrated

You will have disconsecrated

He/She/It will have disconsecrated **They will have disconsecrated**

I will have been disconsecrating

We will have been disconsecrating

You will have been disconsecrating

You will have been disconsecrating

He/She/It will have been disconsecrating **They will have been disconsecrating**
