Present Tense	discourage / discourages
Past Tense	discouraged
Present Participle	discouraging
Past Participle	discouraged

Conjugate Discourage

Discourage in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **discourage** We **discourage**
You **discourage** You **discourage**
He/She/It **discourages** They **discourage**

Discourage in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am discouraging** We **are discouraging**
You **are discouraging** You **are discouraging**
He/She/It **is discouraging** They **are discouraging**

Discourage in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have discouraged** We **have discouraged**
You **have discouraged** You **have discouraged**
He/She/It **has discouraged** They **have discouraged**

Discourage in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been discouraging** We **have been discouraging**
You **have been discouraging** You **have been discouraging**
He/She/It **has been discouraging** They **have been discouraging**

Discourage in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **discouraged** We **discouraged**
You **discouraged** You **discouraged**
He/She/It **discouraged** They **discouraged**

Discourage in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was discouraging We were discouraging
You were discouraging You were discouraging
He/She/It was discouraging They were discouraging

Discourage in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had discouraged We had discouraged
You had discouraged You had discouraged
He/She/It had discouraged They had discouraged

Discourage in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been discouraging We had been discouraging
You had been discouraging You had been discouraging
He/She/It had been discouraging They had been discouraging

Discourage in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will discourage We will discourage
You will discourage You will discourage
He/She/It will discourage They will discourage

Discourage in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be discouraging We will be discouraging
You will be discouraging You will be discouraging
He/She/It will be discouraging They will be discouraging

Discourage in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have discouraged

We will have discouraged

You will have discouraged

You will have discouraged

He/She/It will have discouraged

They will have discouraged

Discourage in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been discouraging

We will have been discouraging

You will have been discouraging

You will have been discouraging

He/She/It will have been discouraging

They will have been discouraging
