## The Forms of Discourage

Infinitive	<b>to discourage</b>
Present Tense	<b>discourage / discourages</b>
Past Tense	<b>discouraged</b>
Present Participle	<b>discouraging</b>
Past Participle	<b>discouraged</b>

## Conjugate Discourage

**Discourage in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>discourage</b>	We <b>discourage</b>
You <b>discourage</b>	You <b>discourage</b>
He/She/It <b>discourages</b>	They <b>discourage</b>

### **Discourage in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am discouraging</b>	We <b>are discouraging</b>
You <b>are discouraging</b>	You <b>are discouraging</b>
He/She/It <b>is discouraging</b>	They <b>are discouraging</b>

### **Discourage in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have discouraged</b>	We <b>have discouraged</b>
You <b>have discouraged</b>	You <b>have discouraged</b>
He/She/It <b>has discouraged</b>	They <b>have discouraged</b>

### **Discourage in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been discouraging</b>	We <b>have been discouraging</b>
You <b>have been discouraging</b>	You <b>have been discouraging</b>
He/She/It <b>has been discouraging</b>	They <b>have been discouraging</b>

### **Discourage in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>discouraged</b>	We <b>discouraged</b>
You <b>discouraged</b>	You <b>discouraged</b>
He/She/It <b>discouraged</b>	They <b>discouraged</b>

### **Discourage in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was discouraging      We were discouraging  
You were discouraging      You were discouraging  
He/She/It was discouraging      They were discouraging

**Discourage in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had discouraged      We had discouraged  
You had discouraged      You had discouraged  
He/She/It had discouraged      They had discouraged

**Discourage in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been discouraging      We had been discouraging  
You had been discouraging      You had been discouraging  
He/She/It had been discouraging      They had been discouraging

**Discourage in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will discourage      We will discourage  
You will discourage      You will discourage  
He/She/It will discourage      They will discourage

**Discourage in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be discouraging      We will be discouraging  
You will be discouraging      You will be discouraging  
He/She/It will be discouraging      They will be discouraging

**Discourage in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have discouraged**

**We will have discouraged**

**You will have discouraged**

**You will have discouraged**

**He/She/It will have discouraged**

**They will have discouraged**

**Discourage in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been discouraging**

**We will have been discouraging**

**You will have been discouraging**

**You will have been discouraging**

**He/She/It will have been discouraging**

**They will have been discouraging**
