Present Participle	discouring
Past Participle	discoured

Conjugate Discoure

Discoure in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **discoure** We **discoure**
You **discoure** You **discoure**
He/She/It **discoures** They **discoure**

Discoure in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am discouring** We **are discouring**
You **are discouring** You **are discouring**
He/She/It **is discouring** They **are discouring**

Discoure in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have discoured** We **have discoured**
You **have discoured** You **have discoured**
He/She/It **has discoured** They **have discoured**

Discoure in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been discouring** We **have been discouring**
You **have been discouring** You **have been discouring**
He/She/It **has been discouring** They **have been discouring**

Discoure in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **discoured** We **discoured**
You **discoured** You **discoured**
He/She/It **discoured** They **discoured**

Discoure in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was discouring We were discouring
You were discouring You were discouring
He/She/It was discouring They were discouring

Discoure in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had discoured We had discoured
You had discoured You had discoured
He/She/It had discoured They had discoured

Discoure in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been discouring We had been discouring
You had been discouring You had been discouring
He/She/It had been discouring They had been discouring

Discoure in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will discoure We will discoure
You will discoure You will discoure
He/She/It will discoure They will discoure

Discoure in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be discouring We will be discouring
You will be discouring You will be discouring
He/She/It will be discouring They will be discouring

Discoure in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have discoured

We will have discoured

You will have discoured

You will have discoured

He/She/It will have discoured

They will have discoured

Discoure in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been discouring

We will have been discouring

You will have been discouring

You will have been discouring

He/She/It will have been discouring

They will have been discouring
