Discover in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I discover We discover

You **discover** You **discover**

He/She/It discovers They discover

Discover in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am discovering We are discovering
You are discovering You are discovering
He/She/It is discovering They are discovering

Discover in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have discovered
You have discovered
He/She/It has discovered They have discovered

Discover in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been discovering
You have been discovering
He/She/It has been discovering
They have been discovering

Discover in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI discoveredWe discoveredYou discoveredYou discovered

He/She/It discovered They discovered

Discover in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was discovering We were discovering
You were discovering You were discovering
He/She/It was discovering They were discovering

Discover in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had discovered
You had discovered
He/She/It had discovered
They had discovered

Discover in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been discovering
You had been discovering
He/She/It had been discovering
They had been discovering

Discover in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will discover
You will discover
He/She/It will discover They will discover

Discover in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be discovering
You will be discovering
He/She/It will be discovering
They will be discovering

Discover in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have discovered
You will have discovered
He/She/It will have discovered
They will have discovered

Discover in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been discovering
You will have been discovering
He/She/It will have been discovering
They will have been discovering
