## Associations of "Discreetly" (30 Words)

<b>advised</b>	Having received information. <i>You would be <b>advised</b> to check on increases to your pension.</i>
<b>alert</b>	A warning serves to make you more alert to danger. <i>Security forces are on the <b>alert</b> for an upsurge in violence.</i>
<a href="#">attentive</a>	Giving care or attention. <i><b>Attentive</b> to details.</i>
<a href="#">beware</a>	Be cautious and alert to risks or dangers. <i>Shoppers were warned to <b>beware</b> of cut price fakes.</i>
<a href="#">careful</a>	Making sure of avoiding potential danger, mishap, or harm; cautious. <i><b>Careful</b> of the rights of others.</i>
<b>carefully</b>	As if with kid gloves; with caution or prudence or tact. <i>They must be <b>carefully</b> handled and stored.</i>
<b>carefulness</b>	The trait of being cautious; being attentive to possible danger. <i>I admired the <b>carefulness</b> of his work.</i>
<b>caution</b>	Warning. <i>Anyone receiving a suspect package should exercise extreme <b>caution</b>.</i>
<a href="#">cautious</a>	People who are fearful and cautious. <i>Firms have been unusually <b>cautious</b> about hiring new workers.</i>
<a href="#">cautiously</a>	In a conservative manner. <i>We must proceed <b>cautiously</b>.</i>
<a href="#">chary</a>	Cautiously or suspiciously reluctant to do something. <i><b>Chary</b> of the risks involved.</i>
<b>circumspect</b>	Heedful of potential consequences. <i><b>Circumspect</b> actions.</i>
<b>conscientious</b>	Wishing to do one’s work or duty well and thoroughly. <i>The individual is denied even the opportunity to break the law on <b>conscientious</b> grounds.</i>

<b>consider</b>	Regard or treat with consideration respect and esteem. <i>I don't <b>consider</b> that I'm to blame.</i>
<b><u>deliberate</u></b>	Consider (a question) carefully. <i>A <b>deliberate</b> attempt to provoke conflict.</i>
<b><u>deliberation</u></b>	Discussion of all sides of a question. <i>The commission's <b>deliberations</b>.</i>
<b><u>discreet</u></b>	Unobtrusively perceptive and sympathetic. <i>A <b>discreet</b> cough.</i>
<b><u>discretion</u></b>	The power of making free choices unconstrained by external agencies. <i>I'll be the soul of <b>discretion</b>.</i>
<b>forethought</b>	Judiciousness in avoiding harm or danger. <i>Jim had the <b>forethought</b> to book in advance.</i>
<b>measured</b>	(of speech or writing) carefully considered and restrained. <i>His <b>measured</b> prose.</i>
<b><u>mindful</u></b>	Inclined or willing to do something. <i>A <b>mindful</b> approach to life helps us to let go of the stress that often comes with conflicts in relationships.</i>
<b>modesty</b>	Behaviour, manner, or appearance intended to avoid impropriety or indecency. <i>With typical <b>modesty</b> he insisted on sharing the credit with others.</i>
<b><u>perfunctory</u></b>	As a formality only. <i><b>Perfunctory</b> courtesy.</i>
<b>precaution</b>	A precautionary measure warding off impending danger or damage or injury etc. <i>He had taken the <b>precaution</b> of seeking legal advice.</i>
<b><u>prudent</u></b>	Acting with or showing care and thought for the future. <i>More <b>prudent</b> to hide than to fight.</i>
<b>solicitous</b>	Eager or anxious to do something. <i>He was <b>solicitous</b> to cultivate her mother's good opinion.</i>
<b>thoughtful</b>	Taking heed giving close and thoughtful attention. <i>A deeply <b>thoughtful</b> essay.</i>
<b><u>warn</u></b>	Give (someone) cautionary advice about their actions or conduct. <i>Traffic signals <b>warned</b> of fog.</i>
<b>wary</b>	Feeling or showing caution about possible dangers or problems. <i>A <b>wary</b> glance at the black clouds.</i>
<b>watchful</b>	Experiencing or accompanied by sleeplessness- Shakespeare. <i>Twenty <b>watchful</b> weary tedious nights.</i>
