Infinitive **to discriminate**

Present Tense discriminate / discriminates

Past Tense **discriminated**Present Participle **discriminating**Past Participle **discriminated**

Conjugate Discriminate

Discriminate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I discriminate
You discriminate
He/She/It discriminates
They discriminate

Discriminate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am discriminating We are discriminating
You are discriminating
He/She/It is discriminating They are discriminating

Discriminate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have discriminated We have discriminated You have discriminated He/She/It has discriminated They have discriminated

Discriminate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been discriminating
You have been discriminating
He/She/It has been discriminating
They have been discriminating

Discriminate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I discriminated We discriminated You discriminated You discriminated He/She/It discriminated They discriminated

Discriminate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was discriminating We were discriminating
You were discriminating
He/She/It was discriminating They were discriminating

Discriminate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had discriminated We had discriminated You had discriminated He/She/It had discriminated They had discriminated

Discriminate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been discriminating
You had been discriminating
He/She/It had been discriminating
They had been discriminating

Discriminate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will discriminate
You will discriminate
He/She/It will discriminate
They will discriminate

Discriminate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be discriminating
You will be discriminating
He/She/It will be discriminating
They will be discriminating

Discriminate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have discriminated
You will have discriminated
He/She/It will have discriminated
They will have discriminated

Discriminate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been discriminating
You will have been discriminating
He/She/It will have been discriminating
They will have been discriminating
