Disgrace in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I disgrace	We disgrace
You disgrace	You disgrace
He/She/It disgraces	They disgrace

Disgrace in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am disgracing	We are disgracing
You are disgracing	You are disgracing
He/She/It is disgracing	They are disgracing

Disgrace in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have disgraced	We have disgraced
You have disgraced	You have disgraced
He/She/It has disgraced	They have disgraced

Disgrace in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been disgracing	We have been disgracing
You have been disgracing	You have been disgracing
He/She/It has been disgracing	They have been disgracing

Disgrace in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I disgraced	We disgraced
You disgraced	You disgraced
He/She/It disgraced	They disgraced

Disgrace in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was disgracing	We were disgracing
You were disgracing	You were disgracing
He/She/It was disgracing	They were disgracing

Disgrace in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had disgraced	We had disgraced
You had disgraced	You had disgraced
He/She/It had disgraced	They had disgraced

Disgrace in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been disgracing	We had been disgracing
You had been disgracing	You had been disgracing
He/She/It had been disgracing	They had been disgracing

Disgrace in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will disgrace	We will disgrace
You will disgrace	You will disgrace
He/She/It will disgrace	They will disgrace

Disgrace in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be disgracing	We will be disgracing
You will be disgracing	You will be disgracing
He/She/It will be disgracing	They will be disgracing

Disgrace in Future Perfect Tense



Singular	Plural
I will have disgraced	We will have disgraced
You will have disgraced	You will have disgraced
He/She/It will have disgraced	They will have disgraced

Disgrace in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been disgracing	We will have been disgracing
You will have been disgracing	You will have been disgracing
He/She/It will have been disgracing	They will have been disgracing
