# **Conjugate Disgraduate**

Disgraduate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I disgraduate
You disgraduate
He/She/It disgraduates They disgraduate

#### Disgraduate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am disgraduating We are disgraduating
You are disgraduating
He/She/It is disgraduating They are disgraduating

#### **Disgraduate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I have disgraduated We have disgraduated You have disgraduated He/She/It has disgraduated They have disgraduated

# **Disgraduate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I have been disgraduating
You have been disgraduating
He/She/It has been disgraduating
They have been disgraduating

#### Disgraduate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I disgraduated We disgraduated You disgraduated You disgraduated He/She/It disgraduated They disgraduated

# Disgraduate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was disgraduating We were disgraduating
You were disgraduating
He/She/It was disgraduating They were disgraduating

#### **Disgraduate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I had disgraduated We had disgraduated You had disgraduated He/She/It had disgraduated They had disgraduated

#### **Disgraduate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I had been disgraduating
You had been disgraduating
He/She/It had been disgraduating
They had been disgraduating

# Disgraduate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will disgraduate
You will disgraduate
He/She/It will disgraduate
They will disgraduate

#### Disgraduate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

**Singular** Plural

I will be disgraduating
You will be disgraduating
He/She/It will be disgraduating
They will be disgraduating

# **Disgraduate in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular Plural

I will have disgraduated
You will have disgraduated
He/She/It will have disgraduated
They will have disgraduated

# **Disgraduate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I will have been disgraduating
You will have been disgraduating
He/She/It will have been disgraduating
They will have been disgraduating
