Present Tense	disgregate / disgregates
Past Tense	disgregated
Present Participle	disgregating
Past Participle	disgregated

Conjugate Disgregate

Disgregate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **disgregate** We **disgregate**
You **disgregate** You **disgregate**
He/She/It **disgregates** They **disgregate**

Disgregate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am disgregating** We **are disgregating**
You **are disgregating** You **are disgregating**
He/She/It **is disgregating** They **are disgregating**

Disgregate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have disgregated** We **have disgregated**
You **have disgregated** You **have disgregated**
He/She/It **has disgregated** They **have disgregated**

Disgregate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been disgregating** We **have been disgregating**
You **have been disgregating** You **have been disgregating**
He/She/It **has been disgregating** They **have been disgregating**

Disgregate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **disgregated** We **disgregated**
You **disgregated** You **disgregated**
He/She/It **disgregated** They **disgregated**

Disgregate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was disgregating We were disgregating
You were disgregating You were disgregating
He/She/It was disgregating They were disgregating

Disgregate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had disgregated We had disgregated
You had disgregated You had disgregated
He/She/It had disgregated They had disgregated

Disgregate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been disgregating We had been disgregating
You had been disgregating You had been disgregating
He/She/It had been disgregating They had been disgregating

Disgregate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will disgregate We will disgregate
You will disgregate You will disgregate
He/She/It will disgregate They will disgregate

Disgregate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be disgregating We will be disgregating
You will be disgregating You will be disgregating
He/She/It will be disgregating They will be disgregating

Disgregate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have disgregated

We will have disgregated

You will have disgregated

You will have disgregated

He/She/It will have disgregated

They will have disgregated

Disgregate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been disgregating

We will have been disgregating

You will have been disgregating

You will have been disgregating

He/She/It will have been disgregating

They will have been disgregating
