# The Forms of Disillusionise

Infinitive	to disillusionise
Present Tense	disillusionise / disillusionises
Past Tense	disillusionised
Present Participle	disillusionising
Past Participle	disillusionised

# **Conjugate Disillusionise**

## **Disillusionise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I disillusionise	We <b>disillusionise</b>
You <b>disillusionise</b>	You <b>disillusionise</b>
He/She/It disillusionises	They <b>disillusionise</b>

## **Disillusionise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am disillusionising	We are disillusionising
You <b>are disillusionising</b>	You <b>are disillusionising</b>
He/She/It is disillusionising	They are disillusionising

### **Disillusionise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have disillusionised	We have disillusionised
You <b>have disillusionised</b>	You have disillusionised
He/She/It has disillusionised	They have disillusionised

## **Disillusionise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been disillusionising	We have been disillusionising
You <b>have been disillusionising</b>	You <b>have been disillusionising</b>
He/She/It has been disillusionising	They have been disillusionising

# **Disillusionise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I disillusionised	We <b>disillusionised</b>
You <b>disillusionised</b>	You <b>disillusionised</b>
He/She/It disillusionised	They <b>disillusionised</b>

## **Disillusionise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was disillusionising	We <b>were disillusionising</b>
You <b>were disillusionising</b>	You <b>were disillusionising</b>
He/She/It was disillusionising	They were disillusionising

## **Disillusionise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had disillusionised	We had disillusionised
You <b>had disillusionised</b>	You had disillusionised
He/She/It had disillusionised	They had disillusionised

#### **Disillusionise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been disillusionising	We had been disillusionising
You <b>had been disillusionising</b>	You had been disillusionising
He/She/It had been disillusionising	They had been disillusionising

# **Disillusionise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will disillusionise	We <b>will disillusionise</b>
You <b>will disillusionise</b>	You <b>will disillusionise</b>
He/She/It will disillusionise	They <b>will disillusionise</b>

## **Disillusionise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be disillusionising	We <b>will be disillusionising</b>
You <b>will be disillusionising</b>	You <b>will be disillusionising</b>
He/She/It will be disillusionising	They will be disillusionising

## **Disillusionise in Future Perfect Tense**

## **Disillusionise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been disillusionising	We will have been disillusionising
You <b>will have been disillusionising</b>	You <b>will have been disillusionising</b>
He/She/It will have been disillusionising	They will have been disillusionising
