# **Conjugate Dismarry**

#### **Dismarry in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>dismarry</b>	We <b>dismarry</b>
You <b>dismarry</b>	You <b>dismarry</b>
He/She/It <b>dismarries</b>	They <b>dismarry</b>

## **Dismarry in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am dismarrying	We <b>are dismarrying</b>
You <b>are dismarrying</b>	You <b>are dismarrying</b>
He/She/It is dismarrying	They are dismarrying

## **Dismarry in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have dismarried	We have dismarried
You have dismarried	You have dismarried
He/She/It has dismarried	They have dismarried

## **Dismarry in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been dismarrying	We have been dismarrying
You <b>have been dismarrying</b>	You have been dismarrying
He/She/It has been dismarrying	They have been dismarrying

## **Dismarry in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I dismarried	We <b>dismarried</b>
You <b>dismarried</b>	You <b>dismarried</b>
He/She/It <b>dismarried</b>	They <b>dismarried</b>

#### **Dismarry in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was dismarrying	We were dismarrying
You <b>were dismarrying</b>	You <b>were dismarrying</b>
He/She/It was dismarrying	They were dismarrying

## **Dismarry in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had dismarried	We had dismarried
You had dismarried	You had dismarried
He/She/It had dismarried	They had dismarried

## **Dismarry in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been dismarrying	We had been dismarrying
You <b>had been dismarrying</b>	You <b>had been dismarrying</b>
He/She/It had been dismarrying	They had been dismarrying

## **Dismarry in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will dismarry	We <b>will dismarry</b>
You <b>will dismarry</b>	You <b>will dismarry</b>
He/She/It will dismarry	They will dismarry

## **Dismarry in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be dismarrying	We will be dismarrying
You <b>will be dismarrying</b>	You will be dismarrying
He/She/It will be dismarrying	They will be dismarrying

## **Dismarry in Future Perfect Tense**

## **Dismarry in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been dismarrying	We will have been dismarrying
You <b>will have been dismarrying</b>	You will have been dismarrying
He/She/It will have been dismarrying	They will have been dismarrying
