## The Forms of Dismay

Infinitive	to dismay
Present Tense	dismay / dismays
Past Tense	dismayed
Present Participle	dismaying
Past Participle	dismayed

# **Conjugate Dismay**

## **Dismay in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>dismay</b>	We <b>dismay</b>
You <b>dismay</b>	You <b>dismay</b>
He/She/It <b>dismays</b>	They <b>dismay</b>

## **Dismay in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am dismaying	We <b>are dismaying</b>
You <b>are dismaying</b>	You <b>are dismaying</b>
He/She/It is dismaying	They are dismaying

### **Dismay in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have dismayed	We have dismayed
You have dismayed	You have dismayed
He/She/It has dismayed	They have dismayed

## **Dismay in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been dismaying	We have been dismaying
You <b>have been dismaying</b>	You have been dismaying
He/She/It has been dismaying	They have been dismaying

## **Dismay in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I dismayed	We <b>dismayed</b>
You <b>dismayed</b>	You <b>dismayed</b>
He/She/It dismayed	They <b>dismayed</b>

### **Dismay in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was dismayingWe were dismayingYou were dismayingYou were dismayingHe/She/It was dismayingThey were dismaying

#### **Dismay in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had dismayed	We had dismayed
You had dismayed	You had dismayed
He/She/It had dismayed	They had dismayed

#### **Dismay in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been dismaying	We had been dismaying
You <b>had been dismaying</b>	You had been dismaying
He/She/It had been dismaying	They had been dismaying

## **Dismay in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will dismay	We will dismay
You <b>will dismay</b>	You <b>will dismay</b>
He/She/It will dismay	They will dismay

## **Dismay in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be dismaying	We <b>will be dismaying</b>
You <b>will be dismaying</b>	You will be dismaying
He/She/It will be dismaying	They will be dismaying

#### **Dismay in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have dismayedWe will have dismayedYou will have dismayedYou will have dismayedHe/She/It will have dismayedThey will have dismayed

## **Dismay in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been dismaying	We <b>will have been dismaying</b>
You <b>will have been dismaying</b>	You <b>will have been dismaying</b>
He/She/It will have been dismaying	They will have been dismaying
