Present Tense	disordain / disordains
Past Tense	disordained
Present Participle	disordaining
Past Participle	disordained

Conjugate Disordain

Disordain in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **disordain** We **disordain**
You **disordain** You **disordain**
He/She/It **disordains** They **disordain**

Disordain in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am disordaining** We **are disordaining**
You **are disordaining** You **are disordaining**
He/She/It **is disordaining** They **are disordaining**

Disordain in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have disordained** We **have disordained**
You **have disordained** You **have disordained**
He/She/It **has disordained** They **have disordained**

Disordain in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been disordaining** We **have been disordaining**
You **have been disordaining** You **have been disordaining**
He/She/It **has been disordaining** They **have been disordaining**

Disordain in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **disordained** We **disordained**
You **disordained** You **disordained**
He/She/It **disordained** They **disordained**

Disordain in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was disordaining We were disordaining
You were disordaining You were disordaining
He/She/It was disordaining They were disordaining

Disordain in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had disordained We had disordained
You had disordained You had disordained
He/She/It had disordained They had disordained

Disordain in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been disordaining We had been disordaining
You had been disordaining You had been disordaining
He/She/It had been disordaining They had been disordaining

Disordain in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will disordain We will disordain
You will disordain You will disordain
He/She/It will disordain They will disordain

Disordain in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be disordaining We will be disordaining
You will be disordaining You will be disordaining
He/She/It will be disordaining They will be disordaining

Disordain in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have disordained

We will have disordained

You will have disordained

You will have disordained

He/She/It will have disordained

They will have disordained

Disordain in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been disordaining

We will have been disordaining

You will have been disordaining

You will have been disordaining

He/She/It will have been disordaining

They will have been disordaining
