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## The Forms of Disorganise

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# **Conjugate Disorganise**

### **Disorganise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>disorganise</b>	We <b>disorganise</b>
You <b>disorganise</b>	You <b>disorganise</b>
He/She/It disorganises	They <b>disorganise</b>

### **Disorganise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am disorganising	We are disorganising
You <b>are disorganising</b>	You <b>are disorganising</b>
He/She/It is disorganising	They are disorganising

#### **Disorganise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have disorganised	We have disorganised
You have disorganised	You have disorganised
He/She/It has disorganised	They have disorganised

### **Disorganise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been disorganising	We <b>have been disorganising</b>
You <b>have been disorganising</b>	You have been disorganising
He/She/It has been disorganising	They have been disorganising

## **Disorganise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I disorganised	We <b>disorganised</b>
You <b>disorganised</b>	You <b>disorganised</b>
He/She/It disorganised	They <b>disorganised</b>

#### **Disorganise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was disorganising	We were disorganising
You <b>were disorganising</b>	You <b>were disorganising</b>
He/She/It was disorganising	They were disorganising

### **Disorganise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had disorganised	We had disorganised
You <b>had disorganised</b>	You <b>had disorganised</b>
He/She/It had disorganised	They had disorganised

#### **Disorganise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been disorganising	We <b>had been disorganising</b>
You <b>had been disorganising</b>	You <b>had been disorganising</b>
He/She/It had been disorganising	They had been disorganising

## **Disorganise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will disorganise	We <b>will disorganise</b>
You <b>will disorganise</b>	You <b>will disorganise</b>
He/She/It will disorganise	They will disorganise

## **Disorganise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be disorganising	We will be disorganising
You <b>will be disorganising</b>	You <b>will be disorganising</b>
He/She/It will be disorganising	They will be disorganising

#### **Disorganise in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have disorganised	We will have disorganised
You <b>will have disorganised</b>	You <b>will have disorganised</b>
He/She/It will have disorganised	They will have disorganised

## **Disorganise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been disorganising	We will have been disorganising
You <b>will have been disorganising</b>	You <b>will have been disorganising</b>
He/She/It will have been disorganising	They will have been disorganising
