# **Conjugate Disorganize**

### **Disorganize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>disorganize</b>	We <b>disorganize</b>
You <b>disorganize</b>	You <b>disorganize</b>
He/She/It <b>disorganizes</b>	They <b>disorganize</b>

### **Disorganize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am disorganizing	We are disorganizing
You <b>are disorganizing</b>	You are disorganizing
He/She/It is disorganizing	They are disorganizing

#### **Disorganize in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have disorganized	We have disorganized
You have disorganized	You have disorganized
He/She/It has disorganized	They have disorganized

### **Disorganize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been disorganizing	We have been disorganizing
You <b>have been disorganizing</b>	You have been disorganizing
He/She/It has been disorganizing	They have been disorganizing

## **Disorganize in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I disorganized	We <b>disorganized</b>
You <b>disorganized</b>	You <b>disorganized</b>
He/She/It <b>disorganized</b>	They <b>disorganized</b>

#### **Disorganize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was disorganizing	We <b>were disorganizing</b>
You <b>were disorganizing</b>	You were disorganizing
He/She/It was disorganizing	They were disorganizing

### **Disorganize in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had disorganized	We had disorganized
You <b>had disorganized</b>	You had disorganized
He/She/It had disorganized	They had disorganized

#### **Disorganize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been disorganizing	We <b>had been disorganizing</b>
You <b>had been disorganizing</b>	You <b>had been disorganizing</b>
He/She/It had been disorganizing	They had been disorganizing

## **Disorganize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will disorganize	We <b>will disorganize</b>
You <b>will disorganize</b>	You <b>will disorganize</b>
He/She/It will disorganize	They will disorganize

## **Disorganize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be disorganizing	We will be disorganizing
You <b>will be disorganizing</b>	You <b>will be disorganizing</b>
He/She/It will be disorganizing	They will be disorganizing

I will have been disorganizing	We will have been disorganizing
You <b>will have been disorganizing</b>	You <b>will have been disorganizing</b>
He/She/It will have been disorganizing	They will have been disorganizing
