Infinitive	<b>to disorient</b>
Present Tense	<b>disorient / disorients</b>
Past Tense	<b>disoriented</b>
Present Participle	<b>disorienting</b>
Past Participle	<b>disoriented</b>

## Conjugate Disorient

**Disorient in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **disorient**                      We **disorient**  
You **disorient**                    You **disorient**  
He/She/It **disorients**        They **disorient**

**Disorient in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am disorienting**                We **are disorienting**  
You **are disorienting**            You **are disorienting**  
He/She/It **is disorienting**      They **are disorienting**

**Disorient in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have disoriented**                We **have disoriented**  
You **have disoriented**            You **have disoriented**  
He/She/It **has disoriented**      They **have disoriented**

**Disorient in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been disorienting**            We **have been disorienting**  
You **have been disorienting**        You **have been disorienting**  
He/She/It **has been disorienting**    They **have been disorienting**

**Disorient in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **disoriented**                      We **disoriented**  
You **disoriented**                    You **disoriented**  
He/She/It **disoriented**          They **disoriented**

**Disorient in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I was disorienting      We were disorienting  
You were disorienting      You were disorienting  
He/She/It was disorienting      They were disorienting

**Disorient in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

I had disoriented      We had disoriented  
You had disoriented      You had disoriented  
He/She/It had disoriented      They had disoriented

**Disorient in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I had been disorienting      We had been disorienting  
You had been disorienting      You had been disorienting  
He/She/It had been disorienting      They had been disorienting

**Disorient in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will disorient      We will disorient  
You will disorient      You will disorient  
He/She/It will disorient      They will disorient

**Disorient in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be disorienting      We will be disorienting  
You will be disorienting      You will be disorienting  
He/She/It will be disorienting      They will be disorienting

**Disorient in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have disoriented**

**We will have disoriented**

**You will have disoriented**

**You will have disoriented**

**He/She/It will have disoriented** **They will have disoriented**

**I will have been disorienting**

**We will have been disorienting**

**You will have been disorienting**

**You will have been disorienting**

**He/She/It will have been disorienting** **They will have been disorienting**
