Disproportionate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I disproportionate	We disproportionate
You disproportionate	You disproportionate
He/She/It disproportionates	They disproportionate

Disproportionate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am disproportionating	We are disproportionating
You are disproportionating	You are disproportionating
He/She/It is disproportionating	They are disproportionating

Disproportionate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have disproportionated	We have disproportionated
You have disproportionated	You have disproportionated
He/She/It has disproportionated	They have disproportionated

Disproportionate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been disproportionating	We have been disproportionating
You have been disproportionating	You have been disproportionating
He/She/It has been disproportionating	J They have been disproportionating

Disproportionate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I disproportionated	We disproportionated
You disproportionated	You disproportionated
He/She/It disproportionated	They disproportionated

Disproportionate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was disproportionating	We were disproportionating
You were disproportionating	You were disproportionating
He/She/It was disproportionating	They were disproportionating

Disproportionate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had disproportionated	We had disproportionated
You had disproportionated	You had disproportionated
He/She/It had disproportionated	They had disproportionated

Disproportionate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been disproportionating	We had been disproportionating
You had been disproportionating	You had been disproportionating
He/She/It had been disproportionating	J They had been disproportionating

Disproportionate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will disproportionate	We will disproportionate
You will disproportionate	You will disproportionate
He/She/It will disproportionate	They will disproportionate

Disproportionate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be disproportionating	We will be disproportionating
You will be disproportionating	You will be disproportionating
He/She/It will be disproportionating	They will be disproportionating

Disproportionate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular	Plural
I will have disproportionated	We will have disproportionated
You will have disproportionated	You will have disproportionated
He/She/It will have disproportionated	They will have disproportionated

Disproportionate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been disproportionating	We will have been disproportionating
You will have been disproportionating	You will have been disproportionating
He/She/It will have been disproportionating	J They will have been disproportionating
