- The feeling of being displeased and discontent.






Synonyms of "Dissatisfaction" as a noun (15 Words)

anger	Belligerence aroused by a real or supposed wrong (personified as one of the deadly sins. <i>I was seething with anger and frustration.</i>
annoyance	An unpleasant person who is annoying or exasperating. <i>The Council found him an annoyance</i> .
disaffection	A state or feeling of being dissatisfied, especially with people in authority or a system of control. <i>There is growing disaffection with large corporations.</i>
<u>disappointment</u>	A person or thing that causes disappointment. I was a big disappointment to her.
discontent	A longing for something better than the present situation. The discontent s of the working class.
discontentment	A longing for something better than the present situation.
disgruntlement	A feeling of sulky discontent. <i>The survey pointed to widespread</i> disgruntlement <i>over recent pay rises.</i>
disquiet	A feeling of worry or unease. Public disquiet about animal testing.
<u>exasperation</u>	A feeling of intense irritation or annoyance. She rolled her eyes in exasperation .



<u>frustration</u>	The feeling of being upset or annoyed as a result of being unable to change or achieve something. <i>Her constant complaints were the main source of his frustration.</i>
<u>irritation</u>	A thing that annoys or irritates someone. Much to my irritation Chris fell asleep.
<u>malaise</u>	A general feeling of discomfort, illness, or unease whose exact cause is difficult to identify. A society afflicted by a deep cultural malaise .
resentment	A feeling of deep and bitter anger and ill-will. Some people harbour resentment s going back many years.
unhappiness	State characterized by emotions ranging from mild discontentment to deep grief. <i>Residents expressed their unhappiness at the council s decision.</i>
<u>vexation</u>	The state of being annoyed, frustrated, or worried.





Usage Examples of "Dissatisfaction" as a noun

- Widespread public dissatisfaction with incumbent politicians.
- *He was never slow to express his dissatisfaction with the service he received.*
