Present Tense	<b>disseat / disseats</b>
Past Tense	<b>disseated</b>
Present Participle	<b>disseating</b>
Past Participle	<b>disseated</b>

### Disseat in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **disseat**

We **disseat**

You **disseat**

You **disseat**

He/She/It **disseats** They **disseat**

## **Disseat in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am disseating**

We **are disseating**

You **are disseating**

You **are disseating**

He/She/It **is disseating** They **are disseating**

## **Disseat in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have disseated**

We **have disseated**

You **have disseated**

You **have disseated**

He/She/It **has disseated** They **have disseated**

## **Disseat in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been disseating**

We **have been disseating**

You **have been disseating**

You **have been disseating**

He/She/It **has been disseating** They **have been disseating**

## **Disseat in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **disseated**

We **disseated**

You **disseated**

You **disseated**

He/She/It **disseated** They **disseated**

## **Disseat in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was disseating**                      We **were disseating**  
You **were disseating**                You **were disseating**  
He/She/It **was disseating**        They **were disseating**

**Disseat in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had disseated**                      We **had disseated**  
You **had disseated**                You **had disseated**  
He/She/It **had disseated**        They **had disseated**

**Disseat in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been disseating**                We **had been disseating**  
You **had been disseating**            You **had been disseating**  
He/She/It **had been disseating**    They **had been disseating**

**Disseat in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will disseat**                      We **will disseat**  
You **will disseat**                You **will disseat**  
He/She/It **will disseat**        They **will disseat**

**Disseat in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be disseating**                We **will be disseating**  
You **will be disseating**            You **will be disseating**  
He/She/It **will be disseating**    They **will be disseating**

**Disseat in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have disseated**

**We will have disseated**

**You will have disseated**

**You will have disseated**

**He/She/It will have disseated** **They will have disseated**

**Disseate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been disseating**

**We will have been disseating**

**You will have been disseating**

**You will have been disseating**

**He/She/It will have been disseating** **They will have been disseating**
