Dissertate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **dissertate** We **dissertate**
You **dissertate** You **dissertate**
He/She/It **dissertates** They **dissertate**

Dissertate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am dissertating** We **are dissertating**
You **are dissertating** You **are dissertating**
He/She/It **is dissertating** They **are dissertating**

Dissertate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

I **have dissertated** We **have dissertated**
You **have dissertated** You **have dissertated**
He/She/It **has dissertated** They **have dissertated**

You were dissertating You were dissertating
He/She/It was dissertating They were dissertating

He/She/It had dissertated They had dissertated

He/She/It had been dissertating They had been dissertating

You will dissertate You will dissertate
He/She/It will dissertate They will dissertate

You will be dissertating You will be dissertating
He/She/It will be dissertating They will be dissertating
