## Associations of "Dissipating" (30 Words)

<a href="#">asunder</a>	Apart. <i>Torn <b>asunder</b>.</i>
<a href="#">diffuse</a>	Spread or diffuse through. <i>A <b>diffuse</b> historical novel.</i>
<a href="#">diffusion</a>	The intermingling of substances by the natural movement of their particles. <i>The <b>diffusion</b> of knowledge.</i>
<a href="#">disappear</a>	Become less intense and fade away gradually. <i>It is estimated that some 7000 people have been <b>disappeared</b> by security forces.</i>
<a href="#">disappearance</a>	The event of passing out of sight. <i>The police were investigating her <b>disappearance</b>.</i>
<a href="#">dispel</a>	Make (a doubt, feeling, or belief) disappear. <i>The brightness of the day did nothing to <b>dispel</b> Elaine's dejection.</i>
<b>dispersal</b>	The splitting up and selling off of a collection of artefacts or books. <i><b>Dispersal</b> of pollen by the wind.</i>
<b>disperse</b>	Denoting a phase dispersed in another phase as in a colloid. <i>The prism <b>dispersed</b> light.</i>
<b>dispersed</b>	Distributed or spread over a considerable extent. <i>Has ties with many widely <b>dispersed</b> friends.</i>
<a href="#">dispersion</a>	The state of being dispersed. <i>Some seeds rely on birds for <b>dispersion</b>.</i>
<a href="#">disseminate</a>	Spread throughout an organ or the body. <i>There is a subset of these low grade tumours that can <b>disseminate</b> and migrate.</i>
<b>dissemination</b>	The action or fact of spreading something, especially information, widely. <i>The <b>dissemination</b> of public information.</i>

<b>dissipation</b>	The squandering of money, energy, or resources. <i>The <b>dissipation</b> of the mist.</i>
<b>dissolution</b>	Debauched living; dissipation. <i>The <b>dissolution</b> of their marriage.</i>
<b>diversify</b>	Spread into new habitats and produce variety or variegate. <i>We re confident that the new owners will grow and <b>diversify</b> the company globally.</i>
<b>effluence</b>	The action of flowing out.
<b>imbue</b>	Fill soak or imbue totally. <i>His works are invariably <b>imbued</b> with a sense of calm and serenity.</i>
<b>intersperse</b>	Scatter among or between other things; place here and there. <i>The debate was <b>interspersed</b> with angry exchanges.</i>
<b>perfuse</b>	Supply (an organ or tissue) with a fluid, typically treated blood or a blood substitute, by circulating it through blood vessels or other natural channels. <i>The isolated <b>perfused</b> rat liver.</i>
<b>pervasiveness</b>	The quality of filling or spreading throughout. <i>The <b>pervasiveness</b> of the odor of cabbage in tenement hallways.</i>
<b>proliferation</b>	Growth by the rapid multiplication of parts. <i>A continuing threat of nuclear <b>proliferation</b>.</i>
<b>prolix</b>	(of speech or writing) using or containing too many words; tediously lengthy. <i>A <b>prolix</b> lecturer telling you more than you want to know.</i>
<b>scatter</b>	The scattering of light other electromagnetic radiation or particles. <i>The light is <b>scattered</b> as it strikes particles suspended in the air.</i>
<b>scattered</b>	(of a person) distracted or disorganized. <i>Changes in the angular distribution of <b>scattered</b> light.</i>
<b>spray</b>	An act of spraying something. <i><b>Spray</b> water on someone.</i>
<b>sprayer</b>	A device, vehicle, or aircraft used for spraying liquids. <i>A paint <b>sprayer</b>.</i>
<b>spread</b>	Distributed or spread over a considerable extent. <i>The very narrow <b>spread</b> between borrowing and deposit rates.</i>
<b>sprinkle</b>	A light shower that falls in some locations and not others nearby. <i>A generous <b>sprinkle</b> of pepper.</i>
<b>strew</b>	Be scattered or spread untidily over (a surface or area). <i>A small room with newspapers <b>strewn</b> all over the floor.</i>

Cause to spread or flush or flood through, over, or across.  
*His whole frame **suffused** with a cold dew.*
