Infinitive	<b>to dissonate</b>
Present Tense	<b>dissonate / dissonates</b>
Past Tense	<b>dissonated</b>
Present Participle	<b>dissonating</b>
Past Participle	<b>dissonated</b>

## Conjugate Dissonate

**Dissonate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>dissonate</b>	We <b>dissonate</b>
You <b>dissonate</b>	You <b>dissonate</b>
He/She/It <b>dissonates</b>	They <b>dissonate</b>

**Dissonate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am dissonating</b>	We <b>are dissonating</b>
You <b>are dissonating</b>	You <b>are dissonating</b>
He/She/It <b>is dissonating</b>	They <b>are dissonating</b>

**Dissonate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have dissonated</b>	We <b>have dissonated</b>
You <b>have dissonated</b>	You <b>have dissonated</b>
He/She/It <b>has dissonated</b>	They <b>have dissonated</b>

**Dissonate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Plural**

I <b>have been dissonating</b>	We <b>have been dissonating</b>
You <b>have been dissonating</b>	You <b>have been dissonating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been dissonating</b>	They <b>have been dissonating</b>

He/She/It <b>was dissonating</b>	They <b>were dissonating</b>

**Dissonate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

I <b>had dissonated</b>	We <b>had dissonated</b>
You <b>had dissonated</b>	You <b>had dissonated</b>
He/She/It <b>had dissonated</b>	They <b>had dissonated</b>

**Dissonate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been dissonating</b>	We <b>had been dissonating</b>
You <b>had been dissonating</b>	You <b>had been dissonating</b>
He/She/It <b>had been dissonating</b>	They <b>had been dissonating</b>

I <b>will dissonate</b>	We <b>will dissonate</b>
You <b>will dissonate</b>	You <b>will dissonate</b>
He/She/It <b>will dissonate</b>	They <b>will dissonate</b>

**Dissonate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will be dissonating</b>	We <b>will be dissonating</b>
You <b>will be dissonating</b>	You <b>will be dissonating</b>
He/She/It <b>will be dissonating</b>	They <b>will be dissonating</b>

**Dissonate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have dissonated**

**We will have dissonated**

**You will have dissonated**

**You will have dissonated**

**He/She/It will have dissonated**

**They will have dissonated**

**Dissonate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been dissonating**

**We will have been dissonating**

**You will have been dissonating**

**You will have been dissonating**

**He/She/It will have been dissonating**

**They will have been dissonating**
