Definitions of "Distaste" as a noun

Synonyms of "Distaste" as a noun (5 Words)

antipathy The object of a feeling of intense aversion; something to be avoided.

His fundamental **antipathy** to capitalism.

aversion A feeling of intense dislike.

My dog s pet **aversion** is visitors particularly males.

disdain A communication that indicates lack of respect by patronizing the recipient.

Her upper lip curled in **disdain**.

disfavour Disapproval or dislike.

The headmaster regarded her with **disfavour**.

dislike An inclination to withhold approval from some person or group.

My **dislike** of him was instinctive.



Usage Examples of "Distaste" as a noun

- His mouth twisted with distaste.
- Harry nurtured a distaste for all things athletic.
