Infinitive	<b>to distinguish</b>
Present Tense	<b>distinguish / distinguishes</b>
Past Tense	<b>distinguished</b>
Present Participle	<b>distinguishing</b>
Past Participle	<b>distinguished</b>

## Conjugate Distinguish

**Distinguish in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>distinguish</b>	We <b>distinguish</b>
You <b>distinguish</b>	You <b>distinguish</b>
He/She/It <b>distinguishes</b>	They <b>distinguish</b>

**Distinguish in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am distinguishing</b>	We <b>are distinguishing</b>
You <b>are distinguishing</b>	You <b>are distinguishing</b>
He/She/It <b>is distinguishing</b>	They <b>are distinguishing</b>

**Distinguish in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have distinguished</b>	We <b>have distinguished</b>
You <b>have distinguished</b>	You <b>have distinguished</b>
He/She/It <b>has distinguished</b>	They <b>have distinguished</b>

**Distinguish in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been distinguishing</b>	We <b>have been distinguishing</b>
You <b>have been distinguishing</b>	You <b>have been distinguishing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been distinguishing</b>	They <b>have been distinguishing</b>

**Distinguish in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>distinguished</b>	We <b>distinguished</b>
You <b>distinguished</b>	You <b>distinguished</b>
He/She/It <b>distinguished</b>	They <b>distinguished</b>

**Distinguish in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was distinguishing      We were distinguishing  
You were distinguishing      You were distinguishing  
He/She/It was distinguishing      They were distinguishing

**Distinguish in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had distinguished      We had distinguished  
You had distinguished      You had distinguished  
He/She/It had distinguished      They had distinguished

**Distinguish in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been distinguishing      We had been distinguishing  
You had been distinguishing      You had been distinguishing  
He/She/It had been distinguishing      They had been distinguishing

**Distinguish in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will distinguish      We will distinguish  
You will distinguish      You will distinguish  
He/She/It will distinguish      They will distinguish

**Distinguish in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be distinguishing      We will be distinguishing  
You will be distinguishing      You will be distinguishing  
He/She/It will be distinguishing      They will be distinguishing

**Distinguish in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have distinguished**

**We will have distinguished**

**You will have distinguished**

**You will have distinguished**

**He/She/It will have distinguished**

**They will have distinguished**

**Distinguish in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been distinguishing**

**We will have been distinguishing**

**You will have been distinguishing**

**You will have been distinguishing**

**He/She/It will have been distinguishing**

**They will have been distinguishing**
