lightheaded Weak and likely to lose consciousness.

scatterbrained Guided by whim and fancy.

A **scatterbrained** blonde.

silly Helpless; defenceless (typically used of a woman, child, or animal).

Silly mid on.

vacuous Having or showing a lack of thought or intelligence; mindless.

A **vacuous** mind.
