## **Conjugate Diverge**

#### **Diverge in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I diverge	We <b>diverge</b>
You <b>diverge</b>	You <b>diverge</b>
He/She/It diverges	They <b>diverge</b>

### **Diverge in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am diverging	We are diverging
You <b>are diverging</b>	You <b>are diverging</b>
He/She/It is diverging	They are diverging

#### **Diverge in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have diverged	We have diverged
You <b>have diverged</b>	You have diverged
He/She/It has diverged	They have diverged

### **Diverge in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been diverging	We have been diverging
You <b>have been diverging</b>	You have been diverging
He/She/It has been diverging	They have been diverging

### **Diverge in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I diverged	We <b>diverged</b>
You <b>diverged</b>	You <b>diverged</b>
He/She/It <b>diverged</b>	They <b>diverged</b>

#### **Diverge in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was diverging	We were diverging
You <b>were diverging</b>	You were diverging
He/She/It was diverging	They were diverging

#### **Diverge in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had diverged	We <b>had diverged</b>
You <b>had diverged</b>	You <b>had diverged</b>
He/She/It had diverged They had diverged	

#### **Diverge in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been diverging	We had been diverging
You <b>had been diverging</b>	You had been diverging
He/She/It had been diverging	They had been diverging

## **Diverge in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will diverge	We <b>will diverge</b>
You <b>will diverge</b>	You <b>will diverge</b>
He/She/It will diverge	They will diverge

## **Diverge in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be diverging	We will be diverging
You <b>will be diverging</b>	You <b>will be diverging</b>
He/She/It will be diverging	They will be diverging

I will have been diverging	We <b>will have been diverging</b>
You <b>will have been diverging</b>	You <b>will have been diverging</b>
He/She/It will have been diverging	They will have been diverging
