Associations of "Dividing" (30 Words)

allocate	Distribute (resources or duties) for a particular purpose. <i>In past years we didn't allocate enough funds to infrastructure maintenance.</i>
allot	Allow to have. <i>I was allotted a little room in the servants block.</i>
apportion	Give out as one's portion or share. <i>Voting power will be apportioned according to contribution.</i>
bifurcate	Divided into two branches or forks. <i>A bifurcate tree.</i>
cleavage	The act of cleaving or splitting. <i>There was a cleavage between the liberal and conservative members.</i>
dichotomy	Being twofold; a classification into two opposed parts or subclasses. <i>A rigid dichotomy between science and mysticism.</i>
dispense	(of a machine or container) supply or release (a product or cash). <i>The machines dispense a range of drinks.</i>
distribute	Distribute or disperse widely. <i>The publisher wants to distribute the book in Asia.</i>
divided	Having a median strip or island between lanes of traffic moving in opposite directions. <i>Opinions are divided.</i>
division	A group of organisms forming a subdivision of a larger category. <i>A growing sense of division between north and south.</i>
fraction	A component of a mixture that has been separated by a fractional process. <i>The dominant classes or fractions in capitalist societies.</i>
fracture	Fracture a bone of. <i>Obsidian shows a conchoidal fracture.</i>

fragmentation	The scattering of bomb fragments after the bomb explodes. <i>The fragmentation of society into a collection of interest groups.</i>
moiety	One of two basic subdivisions of a tribe. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate moiety.</i>
part	Separate the hair of the head on either side of the parting with a comb. <i>The business partners broke over a tax question.</i>
partition	Divide a room into smaller rooms or areas by erecting partitions. <i>Partition chromatography.</i>
<u>portion</u>	The part or share of an estate given or descending by law to an heir. <i>I read a portion of the manuscript.</i>
rend	Cause great emotional pain to. <i>You tell me this in order to make me able to betray you without rending my heart.</i>
rive	Split or crack (wood or stone). <i>The party was riven by disagreements over Europe.</i>
schism	Division of a group into opposing factions. <i>The persistence of this group could produce schism within society.</i>
secant	A straight line that intersects a curve at two or more points.
sectarian	Denoting or concerning a sect or sects. <i>Most sectarians are intolerant of the views of any other sect.</i>
<u>section</u>	Divide into sections. <i>Metal sections were used below ground.</i>
segmentation	The act of dividing or partitioning; separation by the creation of a boundary that divides or keeps apart. <i>Segmentation of myocardial cells.</i>
segregation	The act of segregating or sequestering. <i>The segregation of pupils with learning difficulties.</i>
separated	Separated at the joint. <i>The separated spacecraft will return to their home bases.</i>
<u>separation</u>	The cessation of cohabitation of man and wife (either by mutual agreement or under a court order). <i>Fragile items require separation and cushioning.</i>
<u>split</u>	A single thickness of split hide. <i>They announced a two for one split of the common stock.</i>
sunder	Break apart or in two, using violence. <i>A universe sundered ages ago in a divine war.</i>
