allot	Allow to have. I was allot ted a little room in the servants block.
apportion	Give out as one's portion or share. <i>Voting power will be apportioned according to contribution.</i>
bifurcate	Divided into two branches or forks. A bifurcate tree.
cleavage	The act of cleaving or splitting. There was a cleavage between the liberal and conservative members.
<u>dichotomy</u>	Being twofold; a classification into two opposed parts or subclasses. A rigid dichotomy between science and mysticism.
dispense	(of a machine or container) supply or release (a product or cash. The machines dispense a range of drinks.
distribute	Distribute or disperse widely. The publisher wants to distribute the book in Asia.
divided	Having a median strip or island between lanes of traffic moving in opposite directions. <i>Opinions are divided</i> .
division	A group of organisms forming a subdivision of a larger category. A growing sense of division between north and south.
fraction	A component of a mixture that has been separated by a fractional process. The dominant classes or fraction s in capitalist societies.
<u>fracture</u>	Fracture a bone of. <i>Obsidian shows a conchoidal fracture.</i>



fragmentation	The scattering of bomb fragments after the bomb explodes. The fragmentation of society into a collection of interest groups.
moiety	One of two basic subdivisions of a tribe. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate moiety.</i>
part	Separate the hair of the head on either side of the parting with a comb. The business part ners broke over a tax question.
partition	Divide a room into smaller rooms or areas by erecting partitions. <i>Partition</i> chromatography.
<u>portion</u>	The part or share of an estate given or descending by law to an heir. I read a portion of the manuscript.
rend	Cause great emotional pain to. You tell me this in order to make me able to betray you without rend ing my heart.
rive	Split or crack (wood or stone. The party was rive n by disagreements over Europe.
schism	Division of a group into opposing factions. The persistence of this group could produce schism within society.
secant	A straight line that intersects a curve at two or more points.
sectarian	Denoting or concerning a sect or sects. Most sectarian s are intolerant of the views of any other sect.
<u>section</u>	Divide into sections. Metal section s were used below ground.
segmentation	The act of dividing or partitioning; separation by the creation of a boundary that divides or keeps apart. Segmentation of myocardial cells.
segregation	The act of segregating or sequestering. The segregation of pupils with learning difficulties.
separated	Separated at the joint. The separated spacecraft will return to their home bases.
<u>separation</u>	The cessation of cohabitation of man and wife (either by mutual agreement or under a court order. <i>Fragile items require separation and cushioning.</i>
<u>split</u>	A single thickness of split hide. They announced a two for one split of the common stock.
sunder	Break apart or in two, using violence. A universe sunder ed ages ago in a divine war.
