## Associations of "Dividing" (30 Words)

<b>allocate</b>	Distribute (resources or duties) for a particular purpose. <i>In past years we didn't <b>allocate</b> enough funds to infrastructure maintenance.</i>
<b>allot</b>	Allow to have. <i>I was <b>allotted</b> a little room in the servants block.</i>
<a href="#">apportion</a>	Give out as one's portion or share. <i>Voting power will be <b>apportioned</b> according to contribution.</i>
<b>bifurcate</b>	Divided into two branches or forks. <i>A <b>bifurcate</b> tree.</i>
<b>cleavage</b>	The act of cleaving or splitting. <i>There was a <b>cleavage</b> between the liberal and conservative members.</i>
<a href="#">dichotomy</a>	Being twofold; a classification into two opposed parts or subclasses. <i>A rigid <b>dichotomy</b> between science and mysticism.</i>
<b>dispense</b>	(of a machine or container) supply or release (a product or cash). <i>The machines <b>dispense</b> a range of drinks.</i>
<b>distribute</b>	Distribute or disperse widely. <i>The publisher wants to <b>distribute</b> the book in Asia.</i>
<b>divided</b>	Having a median strip or island between lanes of traffic moving in opposite directions. <i>Opinions are <b>divided</b>.</i>
<b>division</b>	A group of organisms forming a subdivision of a larger category. <i>A growing sense of <b>division</b> between north and south.</i>
<a href="#">fraction</a>	A component of a mixture that has been separated by a fractional process. <i>The dominant classes or <b>fractions</b> in capitalist societies.</i>
<a href="#">fracture</a>	Fracture a bone of. <i>Obsidian shows a conchoidal <b>fracture</b>.</i>

<b>fragmentation</b>	The scattering of bomb fragments after the bomb explodes. <i>The <b>fragmentation</b> of society into a collection of interest groups.</i>
<b>moiety</b>	One of two basic subdivisions of a tribe. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate <b>moiety</b>.</i>
<b>part</b>	Separate the hair of the head on either side of the parting with a comb. <i>The business <b>partners</b> broke over a tax question.</i>
<b>partition</b>	Divide a room into smaller rooms or areas by erecting partitions. <i><b>Partition</b> chromatography.</i>
<u><b>portion</b></u>	The part or share of an estate given or descending by law to an heir. <i>I read a <b>portion</b> of the manuscript.</i>
<b>rend</b>	Cause great emotional pain to. <i>You tell me this in order to make me able to betray you without <b>rending</b> my heart.</i>
<b>rive</b>	Split or crack (wood or stone). <i>The party was <b>riven</b> by disagreements over Europe.</i>
<b>schism</b>	Division of a group into opposing factions. <i>The persistence of this group could produce <b>schism</b> within society.</i>
<b>secant</b>	A straight line that intersects a curve at two or more points.
<b>sectarian</b>	Denoting or concerning a sect or sects. <i>Most <b>sectarians</b> are intolerant of the views of any other sect.</i>
<u><b>section</b></u>	Divide into sections. <i>Metal <b>sections</b> were used below ground.</i>
<b>segmentation</b>	The act of dividing or partitioning; separation by the creation of a boundary that divides or keeps apart. <i><b>Segmentation</b> of myocardial cells.</i>
<b>segregation</b>	The act of segregating or sequestering. <i>The <b>segregation</b> of pupils with learning difficulties.</i>
<b>separated</b>	Separated at the joint. <i>The <b>separated</b> spacecraft will return to their home bases.</i>
<u><b>separation</b></u>	The cessation of cohabitation of man and wife (either by mutual agreement or under a court order). <i>Fragile items require <b>separation</b> and cushioning.</i>
<u><b>split</b></u>	A single thickness of split hide. <i>They announced a two for one <b>split</b> of the common stock.</i>
<b>sunder</b>	Break apart or in two, using violence. <i>A universe <b>sundered</b> ages ago in a divine war.</i>
