# **Conjugate Doctorate**

#### **Doctorate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I doctorate	We <b>doctorate</b>
You <b>doctorate</b>	You <b>doctorate</b>
He/She/It doctorates	They <b>doctorate</b>

### **Doctorate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am doctorating	We <b>are doctorating</b>
You <b>are doctorating</b>	You are doctorating
He/She/It is doctorating	They are doctorating

### **Doctorate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have doctorated	We have doctorated
You have doctorated	You have doctorated
He/She/It has doctorated	They have doctorated

### **Doctorate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been doctorating	We have been doctorating
You have been doctorating	You have been doctorating
He/She/It has been doctorating	They have been doctorating

### **Doctorate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I doctorated	We <b>doctorated</b>
You <b>doctorated</b>	You <b>doctorated</b>
He/She/It doctorated	They <b>doctorated</b>

### **Doctorate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was doctorating	We were doctorating
You were doctorating	You were doctorating
He/She/It was doctorating	They were doctorating

#### **Doctorate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had doctorated	We had doctorated
You had doctorated	You had doctorated
He/She/It had doctorated	They had doctorated

### **Doctorate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been doctorating	We <b>had been doctorating</b>
You <b>had been doctorating</b>	You had been doctorating
He/She/It had been doctorating	They had been doctorating

### **Doctorate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will doctorate	We will doctorate
You <b>will doctorate</b>	You will doctorate
He/She/It will doctorate	They will doctorate

### **Doctorate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be doctorating	We will be doctorating
You <b>will be doctorating</b>	You will be doctorating
He/She/It will be doctorating	They will be doctorating
