## The Forms of Dod

|                    |                   |
|--------------------|-------------------|
| Infinitive         | <b>to dod</b>     |
| Present Tense      | <b>dod / dods</b> |
| Past Tense         | <b>dodded</b>     |
| Present Participle | <b>dodding</b>    |
| Past Participle    | <b>dodded</b>     |

## Conjugate Dod

**Dod in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>       | <b>Plural</b>  |
|-----------------------|----------------|
| I <b>do</b>           | We <b>do</b>   |
| You <b>do</b>         | You <b>do</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>does</b> | They <b>do</b> |

### **Dod in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>             | <b>Plural</b>           |
|-----------------------------|-------------------------|
| I <b>am dodding</b>         | We <b>are dodding</b>   |
| You <b>are dodding</b>      | You <b>are dodding</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>is dodding</b> | They <b>are dodding</b> |

### **Dod in Present Perfect Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>             | <b>Plural</b>           |
|-----------------------------|-------------------------|
| I <b>have dodded</b>        | We <b>have dodded</b>   |
| You <b>have dodded</b>      | You <b>have dodded</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>has dodded</b> | They <b>have dodded</b> |

### **Dod in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>                   | <b>Plural</b>                 |
|-----------------------------------|-------------------------------|
| I <b>have been dodding</b>        | We <b>have been dodding</b>   |
| You <b>have been dodding</b>      | You <b>have been dodding</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>has been dodding</b> | They <b>have been dodding</b> |

### **Dod in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>         | <b>Plural</b>      |
|-------------------------|--------------------|
| I <b>dodded</b>         | We <b>dodded</b>   |
| You <b>dodded</b>       | You <b>dodded</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>dodded</b> | They <b>dodded</b> |

### **Dod in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was dodding**                      We **were dodding**  
You **were dodding**                You **were dodding**  
He/She/It **was dodding**        They **were dodding**

**Dod in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had dodded**                      We **had dodded**  
You **had dodded**                You **had dodded**  
He/She/It **had dodded**        They **had dodded**

**Dod in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been dodding**                We **had been dodding**  
You **had been dodding**            You **had been dodding**  
He/She/It **had been dodding**    They **had been dodding**

**Dod in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will dod**                      We **will dod**  
You **will dod**                    You **will dod**  
He/She/It **will dod**            They **will dod**

**Dod in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be dodding**                We **will be dodding**  
You **will be dodding**            You **will be dodding**  
He/She/It **will be dodding**    They **will be dodding**

**Dod in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have dodded**

**We will have dodded**

**You will have dodded**

**You will have dodded**

**He/She/It will have dodded**

**They will have dodded**

**Dod in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been dodding**

**We will have been dodding**

**You will have been dodding**

**You will have been dodding**

**He/She/It will have been dodding**

**They will have been dodding**
