- *A person who is admired because of their courage and toughness.*
- *A person who acts and gets things done.*



## Synonyms of "Doer" as a noun (19 Words)

<b>accomplisher</b>	Sympathetic compatibility.
<b>achiever</b>	A person who achieves a high or specified level of success. <i>His children are <b>achievers</b> destined to follow an exacting academic route.</i>
<b>activist</b>	A militant reformer. <i>A committed animal rights <b>activist</b>.</i>
<b>actor</b>	A person whose profession is acting on the stage, in films, or on television. <i>He s a principal <b>actor</b> in this affair.</i>
<b>agent</b>	Any agent or representative of a federal agency or bureau. <i>Their research uncovered new disease <b>agents</b>.</i>
<b>author</b>	The writings produced by a particular author. <i>The <b>authors</b> of the peace plan.</i>
<b>effectuator</b>	A person or thing that brings about an event or result. <i>The <b>effectuator</b> of the atonement.</i>
<b>entrepreneur</b>	Someone who organizes a business venture and assumes the risk for it. <i>Many <b>entrepreneurs</b> see potential in this market.</i>
<b>executor</b>	A person who produces something or puts something into effect. <i>The makers and <b>executors</b> of policy.</i>
<b>high achiever</b>	A forward gear with a gear ratio that gives the greatest vehicle velocity for a given engine speed.
<b>hustler</b>	A shrewd or unscrupulous person who knows how to circumvent difficulties. <i>Small time <b>hustlers</b> trying to sell their stuff.</i>
<b>man of action</b>	The generic use of the word to refer to any human being.
<b>operative</b>	A person secretly employed in espionage for a government. <i>A CIA <b>operative</b>.</i>
<b>operator</b>	A person who operates equipment or a machine. <i>Who is the <b>operator</b> of this franchise.</i>
<b>organizer</b>	A person who brings order and organization to an enterprise. <i>She was the <b>organizer</b> of the meeting.</i>
<b>performer</b>	An entertainer who performs a dramatic or musical work for an audience. <i>A circus <b>performer</b>.</i>
<b>perpetrator</b>	A person who carries out a harmful, illegal, or immoral act. <i>The <b>perpetrators</b> of this horrific crime must be brought to justice.</i>
<b>succeeder</b>	A person who takes over or inherits a throne, office, or other position. <i>The true <b>succeeder</b> of his house.</i>

**worker**

Used in Marxist or leftist contexts to refer to the working class.  
*He s a miracle **worker**.*
