# Conjugate Dog-ear

Dog-ear in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I dog-ear We dog-ear
You dog-ear You dog-ear
He/She/It dog-ears They dog-ear

#### Dog-ear in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am dog-earing We are dog-earing
You are dog-earing
He/She/It is dog-earing They are dog-earing

#### **Dog-ear in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I have dog-eared We have dog-eared You have dog-eared You have dog-eared He/She/It has dog-eared They have dog-eared

### **Dog-ear in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I have been dog-earing
You have been dog-earing
He/She/It has been dog-earing
They have been dog-earing

### Dog-ear in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I dog-eared We dog-eared
You dog-eared You dog-eared
He/She/It dog-eared They dog-eared

# Dog-ear in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was dog-earing
You were dog-earing
He/She/It was dog-earing They were dog-earing

#### **Dog-ear in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I had dog-eared
You had dog-eared
He/She/It had dog-eared
They had dog-eared

#### **Dog-ear in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I had been dog-earing We had been dog-earing
You had been dog-earing
He/She/It had been dog-earing They had been dog-earing

# Dog-ear in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will dog-ear
You will dog-ear
He/She/It will dog-ear They will dog-ear

### Dog-ear in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be dog-earing
You will be dog-earing
He/She/It will be dog-earing
They will be dog-earing

### **Dog-ear in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular Plural

I will have dog-eared
You will have dog-eared
He/She/It will have dog-eared
They will have dog-eared

#### **Dog-ear in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular** Plural

I will have been dog-earing
You will have been dog-earing
He/She/It will have been dog-earing
They will have been dog-earing
